Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 0600 UTC to 0600 UTC

General Situation

High pressure will continue to dominate through the rest of Friday and into the weekend, with mainly settled weather around the United Kingdom. However, a frontal system will push south into northern parts through Saturday night.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East veering south 3 or 4, veering west or northwest 5 or 6 later.

Mainly fair.

Mainly good, occasionally poor in Moray Firth.

Moderate, but mainly slight in Moray Firth.
