Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Be aware of high UV levels and sunburn risk.

Forecast for Thursday 03 Jun 2021

Weather: Another dry, warm day with long spells of sunshine. Very low risk of an afternoon shower across Skye and the southern ranges.

Maximum wind: South or southeast 10-20mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 95%.

Visibility: Very good, if rather hazy so distant ranges will lack some clarity.

Temperature: **Glens:** 13C rising to 19-21C.
At 800m: 9-11C.
Freezing level: Well above summits.
