for the period 1800 UTC Sunday 02 June to 1800 UTC Monday 03 June 2019

General Situation

A large area of low pressure to the northwest of Ireland will dominate the weather as it drifts slowly towards northwest Scotland by tomorrow.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic, mainly south 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally slight at first.

Showers.

Good occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 5 to 7, becoming variable 4 or less.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight in Moray Firth.

Showers.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South veering southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time near Rattray Head.

Showers.

Good occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle at first.

Good occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South backing southeast, 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Moderate or good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 to 5, occasionally 6 until later.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain or drizzle at first, then mainly fair.

Good occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 4 or 5, decreasing 3 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Moderate or good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

Southwesterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first.
Slight.
Occasional rain or drizzle at first, then mainly fair.
Good occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southerly 2 to 4.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery rain or showers later.
Good, occasionally poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 2 or 3 overnight.
Slight, occasionally moderate in west.
Showers for a time.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South 2 to 4.
Slight, occasionally moderate in west.
Rain or thundery showers later.
Good, occasionally poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest 4 or 5.
Moderate, occasionally slight.
Showers for a time, otherwise fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southwest, veering west later, 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South 3 or 4, occasionally 5 for a time, veering west later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Good.

Southwest 4 to 6, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or thundery showers.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.
Moderate or rough.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 3 or less, then north 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first near Mull of Kintyre, then decreasing 4 at times later.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough near Mull of Kintyre.
Showers, thundery for a time.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 3 or less, then northerly 4 or 5,

occasionally 6 later.
Moderate or rough.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South veering southwest 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.

Moderate, becoming rough or very rough.

Showers, thundery for a time.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic 3 or less, then north 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, perhaps thundery and prolonged for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor for a time.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming west or southwest 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest veering north 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic 3 to 5, becoming west or southwest 5 to 7.

Moderate, becoming rough or very rough.

Thundery showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, veering north 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A low will move north just to the west of Shetland waters through Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Southeasterly veering southerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east and later in south

Moderate or rough

Rain, drizzle and mist. Occasional fog patches at first.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Monday 03 Jun until 1800 UTC on Monday 03

Jun:

Southerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later in south

Moderate or rough

Occasional rain or showers

Moderate or good, occasionally poor

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 to 5, locally 6, mainly mid-channel, but across the southeast of area 3 to 4 veering west 4 to 5 later this evening and decreasing 3 to 4 overnight, backing southwest after dawn and in the south and east becoming variable 1 to 3 after midday.

Slight, but moderate mid-channel and across northwest of area.

Mist with occasional fog banks, especially across the north and west of area spells of rain and drizzle, clearing to fair conditions between dusk and early hours isolated showers after dawn.

Moderate locally poor or very poor, improving good early tonight.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable or south to southwest 1 to 3, becoming south to southeast 2 to 4 by midnight, then in west veering southwest 4 locally 5 early evening Tuesday.

Slight with a low swell, locally smooth across southeast of area, whilst locally moderate at times across far northwest of area.

Isolated showers then rain from mid-morning spreading eastwards, locally heavy.

Good becoming mostly moderate from mid-morning.

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
