#### General Situation

High pressure over the United Kingdom will drift eastwards with Atlantic fronts following from the west across western and northern areas.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable at times in Moray Firth, otherwise mainly southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.

Mainly slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest backing southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly south or southwest 3 or 4.

Slight.

Fair then occasional rain.

South or southwest backing southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

South or southeast veering southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Mainly slight.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing south or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast veering south or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Mainly slight.

Occasional rain in north later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South backing southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Mainly slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4, becoming mainly southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5.

Mainly slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Mainly southerly or southwesterly, backing southeasterly later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Mainly slight.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Slight.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly southerly or southeasterly 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming mainly southeast 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Slight.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast, veering southwest later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate.

Rain in west later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor in west later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable in east at times otherwise mainly easterly or southeasterly veering mainly southerly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in far northwest.

Smooth or slight in east, slight or moderate in west.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, but mainly 3 in east at first and 6 in west

later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain later in far southwest and far northwest.  
Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Mainly southerly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near western headlands, but increasing 5 or 6 in far northwest later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Mainly southerly 4 or 5 increasing 5 or 6, occasionally 7 near western headlands later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough except in shelter.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, becoming moderate or poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable at times in south at first, 9 otherwise southeasterly veering mainly southerly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north and west.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair then occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southwesterly backing southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6, but mainly 3 in south at first.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast veering south or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Fair then occasional rain or drizzle.  
Good, becoming moderate occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southwest backing south or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain or drizzle, becoming fair later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast 3 or 4 occasionally 5, increasing 6 or 7.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough except in shelter.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel  
24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5, increasing 6 or 7.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough except in shelter.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South or southeast 3 or 4 increasing 5 to 7.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough except in shelter.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south and west at first.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain, fog patches developing in north.  
Mainly good, becoming moderate or poor, occasionally very poor in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 except in far north.  
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough except in shelter.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast 5 or 6, decreasing 4 or 5.  
Mainly moderate.  
Occasional rain, fog patches developing in north.  
Good in north and east at first otherwise moderate or poor, occasionally very poor in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 except in far north.  
Moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Saturday 03 May 2014 at 1800 UTC until Sunday 04 May 2014 at 0600 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
Ridge of high pressure extending north over Shetland will decline, with a frontal trough tracking east across the Isles later Sunday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Variable 2 or 3 becoming southeast 4 or 5.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in west later.  
Fair then occasional rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Sunday 04 May until 1800 UTC on Sunday 04 May:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to east 2 or 3, veering southeast to south overnight, becoming easterly or variable in the afternoon.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair or fine.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly 2 or 3, veering southeast overnight, increasing 4 by morning, further veering south to southwest in the afternoon.  
Smooth or slight with swell.  
Fair or fine becoming cloudy in the afternoon.  
Good.

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
