Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0600 UTC Wednesday 05 November to 0600 UTC Thursday 06 November 2014

General Situation

A trough of low pressure currently lying close to southeastern England will remain slow-moving during today before moving away slowly eastwards tonight. A transient ridge of high pressure will follow from the west, followed in turn by wet and windy conditions.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 5 or 6 becoming variable 3 or 4, then south 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 5 or 6 backing southeasterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in north.

Slight or moderate becoming rough or very rough.

Fair then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North backing south 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 or 6 backing southeast 6 to gale 8.

Slight or moderate becoming rough or very rough.

Fair then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 5 or 6 backing northwest 4 or 5, then south 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming moderate.

Showers, becoming fair later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 4 or 5 backing southeast 6 to gale 8.

Moderate becoming rough.

Fair then rain.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, backing west or southwest 2 or 3 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time in north.

Thundery showers, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 2 or 3 backing southeast 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in south, decreasing 4 at times in north.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly backing southerly 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in east, decreasing 4 in west, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4 becoming southerly 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 later.

Slight becoming moderate then rough.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or less, then south 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4 increasing 6 to gale 8, then veering west or southwest later.

Slight becoming moderate then rough.

Fair then rain, then showers later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in west, becoming variable 3, then southerly 5 or 6 later.

Rough at first west of land's end, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South, veering west or southwest later, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.

Slight or moderate becoming rough or very rough.

Rain, then showers later.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or less, then south 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough at first near Cornwall, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South, veering west later, 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.

Slight or moderate becoming rough or very rough.

Rain, then showers later.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 or less, then south 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, thundery at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South, veering west later, 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 for a time later.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5 decreasing 2 or 3, then veering southeast 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first in northwest, veering westerly 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough in north.

Fair then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5 decreasing 2 or 3, then veering south or southeast 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, then veering west 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time.

Rain.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 4 or 5 becoming variable 3 or less, then south 6 to gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, veering west 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time in east.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast veering southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first in North Channel, veering westerly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough for a time in North Channel.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast veering southeast 3 or 4, increasing 6 to gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough for a time.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly veering southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 6 to gale 8 later, occasionally severe gale 9 later in south.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Fair then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly veering southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 6 to gale 8 later, occasionally severe gale 9 later in south.

Slight or moderate at first in south, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough for a time at first.

Fair then rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low pressure to the southeast will move away southwards as a ridge to the north or northwest declines. Meanwhile, a deep low will track northeast towards Iceland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Northeasterly gale force 8 in operation at time of issue.

Northeast 5 to 7 veering east 3 or 4.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Wednesday 05 Nov until 0600 UTC on Thursday 06 Nov:

East 3 or 4 veering southeast 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northwest to north 4 to 5, decreasing 3 to 4 by evening, becoming variable 1 to 3 overnight, then southerly 3 to 4 by morning.

Slight to moderate.

Scattered showers, dying out this afternoon.

Good, locally moderate in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 3 to 4 increasing 5 to 6 during the morning, further increasing 7 to gale 8 by evening, veering west overnight.

Slight to moderate, becoming rather rough to rough this evening, then rough overnight.

Rain and drizzle in the afternoon, locally heavy, clearing overnight squally showers developing.

Good, becoming moderate to poor in rain or showers.

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
