#### General Situation

A west to northwesterly airflow will prevail across the British Isles during the next 24 hours.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4 for a time later.

Rough for a time to the west and north of Orkney, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 at first near Orkney, otherwise west or northwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough to the west and north of Orkney.

Showers.

Good.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering northwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4, then backing west 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers then fair.

Good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering west or northwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 for a time later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, becoming fair later.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest veering west or northwest, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 for a time later.

Slight, becoming moderate later in north.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north, then becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.  
Fair.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 4 or 5, veering northwesterly 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth later.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 3 or 4 backing southwesterly 5 or 6, then veering northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4 later.

Slight, becoming moderate for a time.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West 4 or 5 veering northwest 3 or 4, then north 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate for a time at first.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 4, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

West veering northwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then veering north later.

Slight in east, slight or moderate in west.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally variable 2 at first, increasing 5 at times later.

Slight, occasionally smooth in east.

Fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in Bristol Channel, veering north 2 or 3 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight later.

Fair.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest 3 or 4, occasionally variable 2 at first, then increasing 5 at times and veering northeast later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fair.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable mainly northwest 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight later.

Showers for a time at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northwest, veering northeast later, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 5 or 6 veering northwest 4 or 5.

Moderate, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers then fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 5 or 6 veering northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.

Moderate, becoming slight later.

Showers then fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.

Slight.

Fair.

Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 at times later.

Moderate or rough at first in far north, otherwise slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 at times.

Slight or moderate in north, smooth or slight in south.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight throughout in Firth of Clyde, but elsewhere slight or moderate.

Showers then fair.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 5 or 6, decreasing 4 at times.

Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight or moderate, becoming slight later.

Showers then fair, then rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time at first in far north.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight later except in far north.

Showers then fair, then rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in north, then decreasing 3 or 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 at times later.

Moderate or rough, becoming moderate.

Showers then fair, then rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Monday 01 Jul 2019 at 0600 UTC until Monday 01 Jul 2019 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Complex area of low pressure over Western Norway extends a trough west over Shetland Waters but a ridge of high pressure is building from the southwest later on Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil at time of issue.

Northwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 for a time in the west.

Moderate, becoming rough for a time.

Rain or showers, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 01 Jul until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 02 Jul:

Northwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Moderate, but rough in the south at first.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, veering north or northwest from late afternoon, then northeast overnight.

Slight, locally moderate.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 3 to 5, becoming locally variable 1 to 3 mid-channel by late afternoon, then generally northeast 4 or 5 Wednesday morning.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fair or fine.

Good.

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
