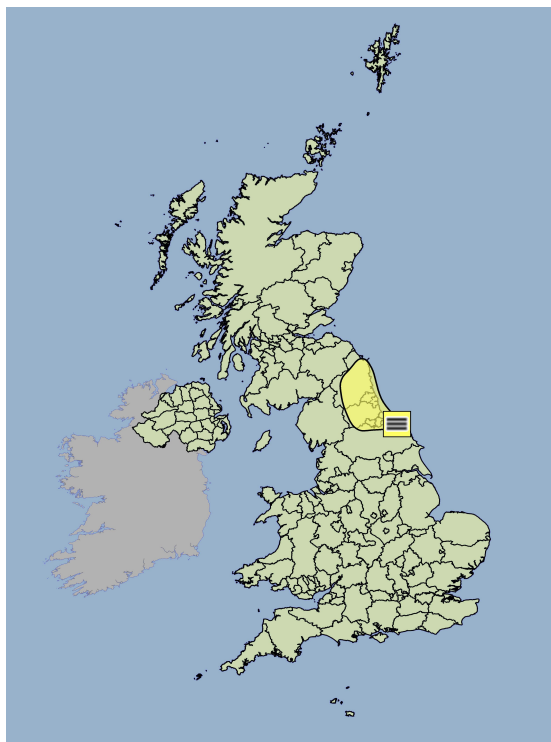




## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

Clear skies and light winds overnight have allowed some dense fog patches to form. Not everywhere will be affected but where fog patches do occur expect visibility to fall below 50 metres in places.

The Met Office have issued a **Yellow Warning of Fog**

Valid from **04:00 on Mon, 14th Mar 2016** until **10:00 on Mon, 14th Mar 2016**

Some dense fog patches have formed overnight with visibility below 50 metres in places. Be aware of the likelihood of some transport disruption and hazardous driving conditions.

The fog will steadily thin and then mostly clear by mid morning.
