Manor House, Haver, Middlesex,
July 13th 1808

Sir,
The extraordinary Heat of yesterday & to-day (with a clear atmosphere & unusually covered in England) induces me to send you a record of a summer at a house in a north-west corner of the house by 2 Thermometers (Bramson & Gary) quite detached.

On Tuesday the 12th sunk at 2 P.M. 65.5 & rose at 87.5
at midnight 69.5

At half past 11 this morning 90.5

And at this instant we have fallen to 89.5

The last Sunday & Tuesday in the year 1790, only amounted to 83.5 in open shaded situations. - The average heat of the West Indies is about 82.5.
