Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Sunday 05 October to 0000 UTC Monday 06 October 2014

General Situation

A deepening frontal depression will move in from the Atlantic to give very windy and wet weather to the west of the British Isles later on Sunday, while a ridge of high pressure in the south moves away eastwards. During Monday, the very windy and wet weather will spread eastwards to all parts, with showery but much calmer conditions following from the west later.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 to 7, then backing southeast 6 to gale 8 later.

Slight at first in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers in north.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough in Moray Firth, otherwise rough or very rough.

Fair at first, then rain at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 or 6, then backing southeast 6 or 7 later.

Slight becoming moderate, becoming rough later in north.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 or 6 later.

Moderate at first in south, otherwise rough or very rough.

Fair at first, then rain at times.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, backing south 4 or 5, then backing southeast 6 or 7 later.

Slight, becoming moderate later.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in north, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate becoming rough.

Fair at first, then rain at times.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West backing south 3 or 4, then backing southeast 5 or 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough.
Fair at first, then rain at times.
Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 4 or 5, becoming variable 2 or 3, then southeasterly 4 or 5 later.
Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Slight becoming moderate, occasionally rough later in north.

Fair at first, then rain, showers later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3, then southeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8, then veering southwesterly 5 to 7 later.

Slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Fair at first, then rain, showers later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor for a time.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest becoming variable 3 or 4, then becoming south 5 to 7 later.

Slight, becoming moderate later.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 6 to gale 8, veering southwest 5 to 7 later.

Moderate becoming rough.

Fair at first, then rain, thundery showers later.

Moderate or good, becoming poor for a time.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 3 or 4, backing southwest 4 or 5, then backing south 6 to gale 8 later.

Slight at first in east, otherwise moderate, becoming rough or very rough later in west.

Showers, rain later in west.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 7 to severe gale 9, veering west 5 or 6, then backing southwest 5 to 7 later.

Rough, occasionally very rough at first.

Rain then thundery showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 3 or 4, backing southwest 4 or 5, then backing south 6 to gale 8 later.

Moderate, becoming rough or very rough later in west.

Showers, rain later in west.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in west, veering westerly 4 or 5, then backing southwesterly 5 to 7 later.

Very rough at first in west, otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain then thundery showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, then backing south 7 to severe gale 9 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough later.

Showers, rain later in west.

Good, becoming moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 in west, veering southwesterly 4 or 5, then backing southerly 5 or 6 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate later.

Rain at first, thundery showers later.

Moderate or poor, becoming mainly good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 or 6, then backing southeast 7 or gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough later in northwest.

Showers, rain later in northwest.

Good, becoming moderate later in northwest.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 in northwest, veering southwesterly 4 or 5, then backing southeasterly 5 or 6 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Rain at times, showers later.

Moderate or poor, becoming good later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 or 6, then backing southeast 7 to severe gale 9 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough later.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast gale 8 to storm 10, veering southwest 4 or 5, then backing southeast 5 or 6 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 or 6, then backing southeast 7 to severe gale 9 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough or very rough later.

Showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast gale 8 to storm 10, veering southwest 4 or 5, then backing southeast 5

or 6 later.
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate later.
Rain at first, then showers.
Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 or 6, then backing southeast 7 to severe gale 9 later.

Moderate, becoming rough or very rough later.

Showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 in North Channel, veering southwesterly 4 or 5, then backing southeasterly 5 or 6 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, backing south 6 to gale 8, then backing southeast 7 to severe gale 9 later.

Moderate, becoming rough or very rough.

Showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast gale 8 to storm 10, veering southwest 5 or 6, then backing southeast 4 or 5 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate later.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, backing south 6 to gale 8, then backing southeast 7 to severe gale 9 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in south.

Showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 in south, veering southerly 5 to 7, then backing southeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate, occasionally slight later.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, backing south 6 to gale 8, then backing southeast 7 to severe gale 9 later.

Rough or very rough.

Showers, rain later.

Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9, occasionally storm 10 in south, veering southerly 5 to 7, then backing southeasterly 4 or 5 later.

Very rough or high, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain at first, then showers.

Moderate or poor, becoming good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Sunday 05 Oct 2014 at 0000 UTC until Sunday 05 Oct 2014 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Weak ridge over Shetland Waters soon declines as Icelandic low deepens and extends trough over Shetland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southwesterly 4 or 5 backing southerly 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Sunday 05 Oct until 0000 UTC on Monday 06 Oct:

Southerly 5 to 7 backing southeasterly 6 or 7.

Rough or very rough.

Rain or showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North to northwest 4, soon decreasing 2 to 3, backing south to southeast Monday afternoon and increasing 4 to 5 by evening, further increasing 6 to 7 by midnight.

Moderate, locally rather rough at first, decreasing slight overnight.

Risk of a shower.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southeast 6 to 7, locally gale 8 in the north, veering west 3 to 5 by afternoon, backing southwest to south 5 by evening.

Moderate to rather rough, increasing rather rough to rough Monday morning, decreasing moderate to rather rough again during the evening, with a swell.

Rain, perhaps locally heavy, clearing around midday Monday then scattered showers.

Good, becoming moderate to poor in rain or showers.

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
