General Situation

High pressure centred over northern Europe brings largely settled conditions over the next few days, although strong winds are possible in the west at times. Fog patches are likely to develop across much of the inshore waters over the next couple of days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming east or southeast 3 to 5 later.

To the west and north of Orkney, moderate, occasionally rough at first, elsewhere smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle until later.

Good, occasionally poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 4 to 6, occasionally 3 at first, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight at first in south, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming east or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East veering south or southeast, 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming east or northeast 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East becoming variable, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

East or northeast becoming variable later, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Good, becoming poor or very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Variable 3 or less, becoming northeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming northeast 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 4 to 6, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in lyme bay.

Showers in west.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming east or northeast 2 to 4 later, occasionally 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in lyme bay.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 3 to 5, occasionally 6 until later, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in far east.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming east or northeast 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in far east.

Fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 to 5, veering south 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near St Davids Head at first.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South becoming variable, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches developing.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast, veering southeast later, 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 to 5.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first in north, otherwise smooth or slight.

Fair.

South or southeast 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate in north, elsewhere smooth or slight.
Fog patches later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
- (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near Mull of Kintyre.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Easterly or northeasterly, veering southerly, 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first near Mull of Kintyre.
Fog patches later.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast veering southeast later, 2 to 4, occasionally 5 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate.
Fair.
Good.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:
Variable 2 to 4, becoming east or northeast 3 to 5 for a time.
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth in central area.
Occasional drizzle and fog patches in north.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in far north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable becoming southeast 2 to 4, then south 4 to 6 later.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near northern and southern entrances.
Occasional drizzle and fog patches at first in far north.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first in north.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath
24 hour forecast:
Variable 2 to 4, becoming east or northeast 3 to 5 for a time.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.
Occasional drizzle and fog patches in north.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor in far north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable becoming southeast 2 to 4, then south 4 to 6 later.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional drizzle and fog patches at first in far north.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first in north.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Waving front remains slow moving over Orkney as the high over Shetland moves slowly east Tuesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

North or northwest 2 to 4.

Moderate or rough, but smooth or slight in waters east of Shetland.

Occasional rain or drizzle, becoming fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Tuesday 05 Sep until 0600 UTC on Wednesday 06 Sep:

Northerly or northwesterly soon becoming variable 2 to 4, increasing southeasterly 5 in the southwest later.

Moderate, but smooth or slight in waters east of Shetland.

Fair, occasional rain or drizzle in the southwest later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

East 3 to 5, veering south to southeast 2 to 4 by midday, becoming variable 1 to 3 in the afternoon, locally calm in the evening, becoming cyclonic 1 to 3 later.

Moderate until late morning in mid channel, otherwise smooth or slight with a low swell.

Mist or fog patches developing later, especially in the north of the area.

Good, locally moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 1 to 3, becoming east to northeast 2 to 4 by midday.

Smooth, locally slight, with a low swell.

Mist or fog patches at times a chance of thundery showers from mid afternoon.

Good, locally moderate to very poor.

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
