Forecast for Saturday 04 Dec 2021

Weather: Mainly cloudy with outbreaks of rain and hill snow in the morning, the snow mainly above 500m. Some longer drier interludes in the afternoon and evening with a few clearer breaks especially in the south where it will become generally dry, but snow showers may pep up across the Aberdeenshire hills in the evening.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 30%, increasing 60%, even higher in the south later

Visibility: Occasionally moderate or poor in rain and snow, very poor in hill fog and blowing snow. Becoming mainly good in the south. The cloud 500-700m lifting and breaking a bit more later especially in the south where it will become mainly clear.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Note the very low feels like temperatures at height.

Forecast for Sunday 05 Dec 2021

Weather: A generally fine day with sunny spells, unbroken across the southern Highlands and the Ochils. Perhaps a light snow shower at first across the Aberdeenshire Hills with some patchy summit cloud possible.

Maximum wind: Northerly 35 gusts 45mph in early hours easing 25 gusts 35 by dawn then down to 10-15mph in the afternoon.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: Generally 90% or more, but 75% in Aberdeenshire.

Visibility: Very good, away from any patchy cloud above 900m in the north.

Temperature: **Glens:** Minus 1 rising to Plus 4 at best then down to Minus 2 in the evening.
At 800m: Minus 3 Celsius
Freezing level: 300m
