Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0000 UTC Sunday 02 June to 0000 UTC Monday 03 June 2019

#### General Situation

Atlantic low will slowly track northeast across northwestern Scotland through Sunday, then will drift north towards Faeroes on Monday, generally bringing a mainly strong southwesterly flow with showers across most areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 in east.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in Moray Firth.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, but 5 or 6 in east, veering southwesterly 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in Moray Firth and rough later in southeast and northwest.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in the firths.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 or 6, veering southwest 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in northeast.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, veering south or southwest 5 or 6.

Slight, occasionally moderate later offshore.

Occasional rain, showers later.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate becoming smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5, veering south or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate offshore.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, decreasing 3 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate offshore, becoming smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4, veering southwesterly 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northeast.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 to 6, backing southerly 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northeast.

Showers at first.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, veering southwesterly 4 to 6.

Slight, occasionally smooth at first and moderate later in west.

Showers later.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, backing southerly 2 or 3 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west, becoming smooth or slight later.

Fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, veering southwest 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Fog patches then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4, veering west or southwest 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in northeast, becoming rough later in west.

Fog patches, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, veering northwest 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, but rough at first in west.

Showers.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 3 or 4, veering southwest 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, backing south 3 to 5.  
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, veering southwest 5 to 7.  
Smooth or slight becoming moderate or rough.  
Showers becoming fair later.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, backing south 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate or rough becoming slight.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7, veering southwest 5 to 7 later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain or showers, becoming fair later.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 to 6, veering southwest 6 or 7 later.  
Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough later.  
Occasional rain and drizzle becoming fair later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.  
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate later.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 to 6, veering southwest 5 to 7.  
Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough later.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate or rough becoming slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, veering southwesterly 5 to 7 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in shelter and rough later in the North Channel.

Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwesterly 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in the North Channel, becoming smooth or slight later.  
Showers.  
Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 4 to 6, veering southwest 4 or 5 for a time, becoming cyclonic 6 to gale 8, then southwest 5 to 7 later.  
Slight at first in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in west.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight later in shelter.  
Showers.  
Good.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7, veering south 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth at first in central areas.  
Occasional rain or showers, fog patches at first.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Cyclonic, becoming southwest, 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south and later in north.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southeast 3 to 5, increasing 6 or 7, veering south 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 5 to 7 later.  
Moderate, occasionally rough in southwest.  
Occasional rain or showers, fog patches at first.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Cyclonic, becoming southwest, 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.  
Moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Sunday 02 Jun 2019 at 0000 UTC until Sunday 02 Jun 2019 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Troughs of low pressure will continue to affect Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

South 3 or 4 backing east or southeast 5 or 6  
Slight or moderate  
Rain, drizzle and mist. Occasional fog patches.  
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Sunday 02 Jun until 0000 UTC on Monday 03 Jun:

East or southeast veering south 4 or 5 occasionally 6 at first  
Moderate occasionally rough in east later  
Rain, drizzle and mist. Occasional fog patches.  
Good, occasionally poor or very poor

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southeast to south 2 to 4, becoming south to southwest in the morning, locally 5 in the north and west of the area, locally variable jersey southwards, becoming westerly 3 to 5 in the evening.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate in the northwest of the area in the afternoon.

Mist and a risk of fog patches, mainly in the north and west of the area during the morning, more widespread later showers from late morning, clearing by midnight.

Good, occasionally moderate or poor, perhaps locally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 3 to 4, perhaps locally 5 at first, backing southwesterly 2 to 4 from dawn, locally variably jersey southwards, further backing southerly by late evening.

Slight, with a low swell.

Isolated showers.

Good, locally moderate in showers.

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
