Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0600 UTC Wednesday 03 May to 0600 UTC Thursday 04 May 2017

General Situation

A large area of high pressure centred over the Norwegian Sea will maintain an easterly or northeasterly airflow across the British Isles. This will bring settled conditions for most, but weak weather fronts moving across southeastern England will keep conditions more changeable here.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Easterly backing northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in north.

Slight, occasionally moderate later near Orkney.

Fair.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near Cape Wrath and in inner Moray Firth.

Slight in Moray Firth, otherwise slight or moderate.

Northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first, veering east 5 to 7 later.
Slight or moderate throughout in east, but in west mainly moderate, occasionally rough later.

Northeast 4 or 5, occasionally variable 3 at first, then increasing 6 at times.
Moderate in west, slight or moderate in east.

24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4 for a time.
Slight or moderate.

increasing 6 at times later in south.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Fair weather will persist across the Shetland Waters, which will lie in a
freshening east to northeasterly airflow.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 except in far west and far southwest.

Slight becoming moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Wednesday 03 May until 0600 UTC on Thursday 04 May:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east and north, then veering easterly 3 later in southeast.

Moderate, becoming rough in north.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 to 4 jersey southwards this morning and again overnight otherwise 4 to 5, locally 6 guernsey northwards.

Slight in the south and east, moderate in the north and west, perhaps locally rather rough by midnight.

Isolated showers.

Good, locally moderate at times.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 to 5, occasionally 6 in the north of the area, generally increasing 5 to 6 by late afternoon.

Slight in the south and east, moderate to rather rough in the north and west, with a low swell.

Isolated showers, mainly Thursday morning.

Good, locally moderate in showers.
