General Situation

Pressure will remain high across the United Kingdom during the coming days, bringing mainly settled conditions to all areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5 near Cape Wrath, otherwise variable, mainly southerly, 3 or 4, but southeasterly 4 or 5 until later in east.

Rough at first in northwest, otherwise slight or moderate.

Occasional drizzle in north.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, becoming variable 3 or less later in west.

Slight in southeast, moderate in northwest.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 until later in north.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional drizzle, mainly in north.

Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south or southeast 3 or 4, then becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north and far south.

Occasional rain, mainly later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 until later in north.

Rough becoming moderate.

Occasional drizzle, mainly in north.

Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south or southeast 3 or 4, then becoming variable 3 or less later.

Moderate.

Occasional rain, mainly later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Ridge of high pressure extends west from Baltic across much of UK, however troughs will move over Shetland at times with low moving into Norwegian Sea.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, backing southeasterly 3 or 4 in southwest.

Moderate or rough but slight close to lee of east Shetland.
Occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Wednesday 03 Sep until 1800 UTC on Wednesday 03 Sep:
Southeasterly 3 or 4 at first and later in southeast otherwise southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate, but occasionally rough in northwest.
Occasional rain at first.
Good, occasionally moderate in west.

Channel Islands
24 hour forecast:
Northeast to east 3 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 late Wednesday afternoon.
Slight.
Mist and a risk of fog patches towards dawn, clearing by mid-morning.
Good, locally moderate to very poor for a time.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northeast to east 3 to 4, locally 5 at first.
Slight with a low swell.
Mist and a risk of fog patches around dawn.
Good, locally moderate to very poor around dawn.

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
