General Situation

A ridge of high pressure over the British Isles brings a cool northwesterly flow which soon veers northeasterly in the south.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3 at first in north, otherwise west or northwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time north of Orkney.

Showers.
