#### General Situation

The complex low over Britain will drift east on Tuesday and Wednesday. A new developing low and associated frontal system will move in from the west on Thursday.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in north.

Slight at first in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later near Rattray Head.

Rain then showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 to 7, becoming variable 3 or 4, then southeasterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first near Rattray Head.

Showers.

Good.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first in south.

Slight at first, otherwise moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later near Rattray Head.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 5 or 6 becoming variable 3 or 4, then southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later in north.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first near Rattray Head.

Showers.

Good.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 3 or 4 veering north 5 or 6.

Slight becoming moderate or rough.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then south 5 or 6 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers at first.

Good.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest veering north 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North 5 or 6 becoming variable 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.  
Showers at first.  
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Cyclonic 4 or 5 becoming northerly 6 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate in north.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, backing westerly 3 or 4 later.  
Slight or moderate.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwesterly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then northwesterly 5 or 6.  
Slight or moderate.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northwesterly 5 or 6 becoming variable 3 or 4 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate.  
Thundery showers, mainly in east.  
Good, occasionally moderate in east.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis  
24 hour forecast:  
West 3 or 4 veering north 4 or 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
North 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then south 5 or 6 later.  
Slight, occasionally moderate.  
Rain later in west.  
Good, occasionally moderate later in west.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.  
Moderate, occasionally rough in west.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northerly or northwesterly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then southerly 5 to 7 later.  
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight in east.  
Showers, rain later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwesterly 5 or 6.  
Moderate or rough.  
Thundery showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwesterly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then southerly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later near St Davids Head.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight for a time.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly veering northerly 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in far south.

Showers, thundery in west.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northerly 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, then southerly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later in west.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in south.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 or 4, then southeast 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth for a time.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, decreasing 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North, veering south or southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 7 or gale 8 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 5 or 6 veering northeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough for a time in north.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 4 or 5 veering southeast 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.

Rain later.

Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 5 or 6 veering northeasterly 4 or 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeasterly veering southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 later in west.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.  
Rain later.  
Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
North 5 to 7 veering northeast 4 or 5.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Northeast veering southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 later, perhaps severe gale 9 later in west.  
Slight or moderate, becoming rough later.  
Rain later.  
Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeast 5 to 7, veering east 4 or 5 later.  
Rough becoming slight or moderate, occasionally smooth in south.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East veering southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later.  
Rain later.  
Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northeast 5 to 7, veering east 4 or 5 later.  
Rough or very rough becoming moderate.  
Showers.  
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East veering southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8, perhaps severe gale 9 later in west.  
Moderate becoming rough or very rough.  
Rain later.  
Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor later.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

#### General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will cover the North Sea on Tuesday with a strong northeast airflow over Shetland. During Wednesday a ridge will build to the NW of your location.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Northeasterly gale force 8 continuing issued on Tuesday 4 November 2014 at 0343 UTC

Northeasterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally 5 later.  
Rough or very rough.  
Showers.  
Good occasionally moderate.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Wednesday 05 Nov until 1200 UTC on Wednesday 05 Nov:  
Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally 4 in northeast.  
Rough or very rough, becoming moderate later in southwest.  
Showers dying out.  
Good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwest 3 to 4 increasing 5 to 6 during the afternoon, veering north overnight, decreasing 4 to 5 by morning.  
Slight to moderate becoming moderate to rather rough for a time.  
Isolated showers.  
Good except in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
North 4 to 5 decreasing 3 to 4 in the evening, becoming variable then southerly 2 or 3 overnight, increasing 4 to 5 Thursday morning, locally 6 later.  
Slight or moderate with swell.  
Rain in the west by Thursday afternoon.  
Good.

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
