Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1800 UTC to 1800 UTC

General Situation

A strong, mainly westerly airflow will affect all inshore waters at first. Rain will spread eastwards across northern areas on Saturday and Sunday, whilst pressure builds across southern areas.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest backing south or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in east.

Showers then rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Slight or moderate, increasing rough in north later.

Rain then showers.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed - (SWW)

Moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Showers, rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing south 5 or 6, occasionally 7.

Slight in east, moderate or rough in north.

Occasional rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

Northwest backing southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, rain later.

Deep Low in Northern North Sea will drift over Scandinavia tonight and fill. A ridge will build over

Southern Britain as a Low southeast of Iceland pushes a waving frontal trough eastwards across

Scotland and the East Shetland basin.

Northwest 5 to 7, decreasing 3 or 4.
