Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Friday 03 December to 0600 UTC Saturday 04 December  
2010

#### General Situation

A ridge of high pressure over Scotland will move southwards during rest of tonight. A new low will become established near northern Scotland by Friday, this low then sinking southwards across the United Kingdom on Saturday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6, increasing 7 for a time in northwest, becoming cyclonic later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in far north.

Rain or snow.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, becoming northerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally 4 at first.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough later in north, but mainly slight in Moray Firth.

Wintry showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, veering west 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair, occasional snow later.

Good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 3 or 4, veering northwest 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later towards Rattray Head.

Occasional snow then wintry showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional snow later.

Good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 or 4, veering northwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, but smooth inshore.

Occasional rain or snow.

Good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Snow or snow showers, fair for a time.

Good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, decreasing 3 or 4, veering west, then northwest later.

Slight or moderate, but smooth inshore.

Occasional rain or snow.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly northwesterly, backing southerly 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate.

Wintry showers, rain or snow later.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, veering westerly 3 or 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.

Occasional rain or sleet.

Good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, backing southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.

Wintry showers, rain or sleet later.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 for a time in east, veering westerly 4 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 4 or 5, becoming variable, mainly southwest 3 or 4, backing south 5 to 7 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.

Mainly fair, rain or sleet later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, veering west 4 at times.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming south 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7, veering west or southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.

Wintry showers, then rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 at times.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming south 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7, veering west or southwest 4

or 5 later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.  
Wintry showers, then rain.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or southwest, veering northwest at times, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times in south, veering northeast later.  
Slight or moderate, becoming rough.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable becoming southwest 3 or less, increasing 5 to 7, veering west or southwest 3 or 4 later.  
Moderate, decreasing smooth or slight for a time.  
Wintry showers, then rain or snow.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or southwest, veering north or northwest later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5.  
Slight or moderate.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable, becoming southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7 for a time.  
Smooth or slight, becoming mainly moderate.  
Wintry showers, rain or snow for a time.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West or southwest, veering north or northwest 3 or 4.  
Slight.  
Occasional rain or snow, then wintry showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South to southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, veering west 4 or 5, decreasing 3 or 4 later.  
Slight, becoming moderate for a time.  
Showers, rain for a time.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 or 3, then north or northwest 3 or 4 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southwest 5 to 7, veering northwest 4 or 5, veering north or northeast later.  
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate.  
Rain or snow, then wintry showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
North or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6.  
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north.

Wintry showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7 for a time, veering west or southwest later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate.

Rain or snow, then wintry showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West veering northwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, veering north or northeast later.

Slight or moderate.

Wintry showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 to 7, veering west 4 or 5, veering north or northeast later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain or snow, then wintry showers.

Good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Wintry showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 to 7, veering northwest 4 or 5, then north 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate south of skye.

Rain or snow, then wintry showers.

Good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 5 to 7, backing northwest later.

Slight for a time near skye, otherwise moderate, becoming rough or very rough in north.

Wintry showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 to 7, veering northwest 4 or 5, then north 5 or 6 later.

Slight, becoming moderate or rough.

Rain or snow, then wintry showers.

Good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 5 to 7, backing northwest later.

Moderate or rough, becoming very rough in north and west.

Wintry showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

## Shetland Isles

### General Situation

Ridge will decline as shallow low and frontal trough move east into Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: \*

South 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain and snow.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Friday 03 Dec until 0600 UTC on Saturday 04 Dec:

Southerly backing easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east later.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain and snow.

Good, occasionally poor.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North 5, decreasing 2 to 4 by midday, backing southwest 4 by dusk then south 5 to 7 by midnight, veering southwest 4 to 5 late in period.

Rather rough, decreasing slight to moderate for a time.

Occasional snow showers at first rain later.

Good, but moderate or poor in precipitation.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 to 5, soon increasing 6 to 7.

Rather rough in the south to rough in the north.

Outbreaks of rain risk of fog patches.

Moderate, locally poor or very poor.
