Forecast for Wednesday 07 Dec 2022

Weather: Dry and mainly sunny or clear, although a few mist or freezing fog patches possible in the valleys, these slowly clearing through the morning. Small chance of a snow shower. Cold with some wind chill over the summits.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 600m: 90%

Low cloud and visibility: No significant cloud expected. Visibility very good or excellent, with clear views of distant hills, but briefly poor or very poor in any isolated snow showers.

Meteorologist's View

Ice and frozen surfaces expected, with freezing level lowering later in the day.

Forecast for Thursday 08 Dec 2022

Weather: Dry with clear skies overnight, although a few mist or freezing fog patches possible in the valleys. A risk of some snow showers during the day, although these more likely in the west of the Park. Some uncertainty in extent of snow showers, however.

Maximum wind: North or Northwest 10-15mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops 600m: 90%, perhaps falling to 60% if snow showers become more widespread.

Low cloud and visibility: Occasional or extensive cloud at 300-400m or less in any snow showers. Visibility very good or excellent, except in any snow showers.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Minus 5 rising to Plus 1 Celsius for a time in the afternoon
At 600m: Minus 2 Celsius
Freezing level: All levels, perhaps rising to around 200m for a time in the afternoon.
