General Situation

A complex area of low pressure will remain slow moving over the eastern Atlantic. An anticyclone will develop across northern France on Monday morning, before then moving to southern Germany by the end of the day.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

East, becoming variable, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, showers for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming east or northeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later in north.

Rain later, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4.

Slight.

Thundery showers at first.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming south or southeast, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair then rain for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southeast, veering south or southwest, 3 or 4.

Slight.

Thundery showers at first.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Rain for a time, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming south or southwest, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers at first.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Rain for a time, showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery rain at first.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair, rain or showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time in east.

Slight.

Thundery rain at first.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Mainly fair, rain or showers later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Showers at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, veering west or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight, becoming moderate.

Showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, backing southerly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later in far west.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers at first, rain later in west.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly, veering westerly later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in far west.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time in far west.

Rain or showers, fair at first in east.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, backing south 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 later in west.

Slight or moderate.

Thundery showers at first, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South, veering west later, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in west, but 4 at

first in the Bristol Channel.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time in west.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 3 or 4, backing southeast 5 or 6 later, occasionally 7 later near St Davids Head.
Slight or moderate.
Thundery showers at first, rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast, veering southwest, 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.
Slight or moderate, becoming rough for a time.
Occasional rain then showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
Southeast, veering southwest for a time, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery showers at first.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 3 or 4, veering south 5 or 6, then veering west later.
Slight, becoming moderate for a time in north.
Showers, rain at first.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
South or southeast, veering southwest, 3 or 4, then backing southeast 4 or 5 later.
Slight, occasionally moderate later.
Showers then fair, rain later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, then veering southwest 5 or 6.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough.
Occasional rain and drizzle then showers.
Moderate, occasionally poor, becoming good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South, veering southwest for a time, 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery showers at first, rain later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, veering south 4 or 5, then veering southwest later.
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate for a time.
Showers, rain at first.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Southeasterly, veering southwesterly for a time, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first

in the North Channel, then increasing 5 later.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery showers at first.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, veering southerly 4 or 5, then veering southwesterly later.
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate for a time.
Showers, rain at first.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.
Slight.
Thundery showers at first.
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6, then veering south or southwest 4 or 5.
Slight, occasionally moderate.
Showers, rain at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:
Easterly or southeasterly, becoming variable, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Showers for a time.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4, becoming easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north, then becoming variable 4 in south.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far south and in far north.
Fair then rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath
24 hour forecast:
Easterly or southeasterly, becoming variable, 3 or 4.
Slight, occasionally moderate.
Showers for a time.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4, becoming easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north, then becoming variable 4 in south.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in north.
Fair then rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Sunday 05 Jul 2015 at 1200 UTC until Monday 06 Jul 2015 at 0000 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A light and stable airflow covers Shetland and surrounding waters on Sunday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil.

Variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 06 Jul until 1200 UTC on Monday 06 Jul:

Variable 3 or less becoming west 4 or 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate in northwest.

Rain at times, fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 2 to 4, veering west and increasing 4 to 5 by mid-afternoon, decreasing 3 to 4 overnight and backing southerly by the morning.

Slight to moderate.

Isolated thundery showers.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast to south 3 to 4, veering south to southwest overnight and increasing 4 to 5, occasionally 6 in the morning, veering west later.

Slight with a low swell, becoming moderate to rather rough Tuesday morning.

Occasional rain Tuesday morning, with a risk of thunder.

Good, becoming moderate to poor in rain.

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
