Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1800 UTC to 1800 UTC

General Situation

A vigorous area of low pressure over the United Kingdom today will move away northeastwards on Monday.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly backing westerly or northwesterly, 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7 later.

Rough or very rough.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Mainly westerly 5 to 7, backing southeasterly for a time.

Rough occasionally very rough in north.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Cyclonic becoming southwest 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, backing south for a time.

Mainly moderate.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or poor becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, backing south for a time.

Mainly moderate.

Rain or squally showers.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

Southwest 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7 later.

Moderate or rough.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

Moderate or rough.

Southwesterly backing southerly for a time, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Moderate occasionally rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first in east, decreasing 5 or 6 later.

Rough.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly backing southerly for a time 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly veering northwesterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5.

Rough.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or northwesterly 4 or 5, backing southwest 6 to gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time, decreasing 5 or 6, backing south later.

Rough or very rough.

Squally showers, rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering west 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8.

Rough or very rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time, decreasing 5 or 6, backing southerly later.

Rough or very rough.

Squally showers, rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly veering westerly 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8.

Rough, but very rough in west.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 or 6, backing southerly later.

Rough.

Squally showers, rain later.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 5 or 6 veering westerly 6 to gale 8.

Rough, occasionally very rough in southwest.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 7 to severe gale 9, backing southwesterly 5 to 7 later.

Rough.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 6 to gale 8, backing southwest 4 or 5 later.

Rough becoming moderate.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5 increasing 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 7 to severe gale 9, backing southwest 5 to 7 later.

Mainly rough.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Good becoming moderate or poor later.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 7 to severe gale 9, backing southwest 5 to 7 later.
Rough or very rough.
Rain then squally showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.
Rough.
Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwest 7 to severe gale 9, backing southwest 5 to 7 later.
Rough or very rough.
Rain then squally showers.
Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.
Rough or very rough.
Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in south, backing southwesterly 5 to 7 later.
Rough or very rough.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly backing southeasterly for a time 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.
Rough or very rough.
Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or good occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in south, backing southwesterly 5 to 7 later.
Moderate, occasionally rough in far north and far south.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly backing southeasterly for a time 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.
Moderate, occasionally rough in far north and far south.
Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or good occasionally poor.

The Channel Islands - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West 6 or 7 locally gale 8, decreasing 5 to 7 overnight, veering northwest 5 to 6 by dawn tomorrow,
backing west to southwest 4 to 5 by evening.
Very rough slowly moderating.
Scattered showers with a risk of thunder, then rain by tomorrow evening.
Good except in showers or rain.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest backing south 4 to 5, veering west early Tuesday increasing 6 to gale 8.

Becoming rough.

Rain, perhaps heavy at times, clearing to scattered showers during Tuesday afternoon.

Moderate to poor becoming good except in showers.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A depression off Northeast Scotland will move across Shetland Monday morning.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Easterly severe gale 9 in force at time of issue

East becoming cyclonic 7 to severe gale 9.

Rough or very rough.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Monday 02 Nov until 1800 UTC on Monday 02 Nov:

Cyclonic 7 to severe gale 9 becoming southwest 5 to 7.

Rough or very rough.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or poor becoming mainly good.

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
