General Situation

A developing area of low pressure close to the Southwest Approaches will maintain a brisk easterly gradient, with thundery showers continuing in the south and southwest.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Easterly backing northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 later in west.

Slight or moderate, but mainly smooth in Moray Firth for a time.

Fog patches in east.
