Forecast for Friday 03 Feb 2023

Weather: Low cloud with outbreaks of light rain and drizzle to start, clearing away to the northeast through the morning. Bright with sunny spells during the afternoon. Slightly cloudier into the evening.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 10% at first, increasing to 90% by mid-morning.

Low cloud and visibility: Extensive low cloud and hill fog at first, this clearing with good visibility by mid-morning.

Meteorologist's View

Very strong winds at first. Due to a technical error the wind/temperature details can currently only be viewed in the printable pdf version of this forecast.

Forecast for Saturday 04 Feb 2023

Weather: A bright start to the day but low cloud and outbreaks of rain pushing in from the northwest by midday. This clearing later in the afternoon to leave sunny or clear spells.

Maximum wind: Southwest 15-20 mph gusting 30-35 mph becoming westerly and decreasing later.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 700m: 90% but 30% on the front.

Low cloud and visibility: Good but some low cloud on the front with moderate visibility in the rain.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 8 falling to plus 4 Celsius.
At 700m: Plus 4 falling to minus 1 Celsius.
Freezing level: 1400m falling to 600m into the evening.
