Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1700 UTC to 1700 UTC.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney.

24 hour forecast:

Wind: northwesterly backing southerly 6 or 7, decreasing 4 for a time this evening and veering westerly tomorrow morning.

Weather: rain spreading from west overnight followed by showers.

Visibility: moderate or good.

Sea State: rough or very rough, locally moderate in Moray Firth.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: west backing southwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 for a time around Cape Wrath and Orkney.

Weather: showers, rain later.

Visibility: moderate or good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill.

Wind: southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, later veering northwest.
Weather: rain or showers.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis.
24 hour forecast:
Wind: West backing southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first around exposed headlands.
Weather: isolated showers with occasional rain later.
Visibility: mainly good.
Sea State: moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Wind: southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6, later veering northwesterly.
Weather: rain or showers.
Visibility: moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly.
24 hour forecast:
Wind: west backing southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first around exposed headlands.
Weather: isolated showers with occasional rain later.
Visibility: mainly good.
Sea State: moderate or rough, occasionally very rough around Isles of Scilly at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Wind: southwest, backing south for a time, 4 or 5 occasionally 6 or 7, later veering northwest.
Weather: rain or showers.
Visibility: moderate or good.
Sea State: moderate or rough.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel.
24 hour forecast:
Wind: west, backing southwest for a time, 4 or 5 occasionally 6 at first around exposed headlands.
Weather: isolated showers with occasional rain later.
Visibility: mainly good.
Sea State: rough becoming moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Wind: west 4 or 5 becoming cyclonic 5 to 7 for a time.
Weather: rain or showers.
Visibility: moderate or good.
Sea State: moderate occasionally rough.

St Davids Head to Colwyn Bay, including St Georges Channel.

24 hour forecast:

Wind: west 4 or 5, backing southwest 5 or 6 for a time after midnight.
Weather: rain at times.

Isle of Man.

Weather: showers, rain later.
Visibility: moderate or good.
Sea State: moderate occasionally rough to west of Fair Head.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel.

24 hour forecast:

Wind: Westerly backing southwesterly 4 or 5, increasing 5 to 7.
Weather: rain spreading from the west overnight, followed by showers.
Visibility: moderate or good.
Sea State: moderate occasionally rough.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Wind: southwest 5 or 6 increasing 6 or 7.
Weather: showers, rain later.
Visibility: moderate or good.
Sea State: moderate occasionally rough.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point.
24 hour forecast:
Wind: West backing south or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 occasionally 7.
Weather: rain then showers.
Visibility: moderate or good.
Sea State: rough or very rough.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Wind: southwesterly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 at times.
Weather: showers, rain later.
Visibility: moderate or good.
Sea State: rough or very rough.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides.
24 hour forecast:
Wind: West backing south or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 around Outer Hebrides.
Weather: rain then showers.
Visibility: moderate or good.
Sea State: rough or very rough, occasionally high around Outer Hebrides later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Wind: southwesterly 6 to Gale 8.
Weather: showers, rain later.
Visibility: moderate or good.
Sea State: rough or very rough, locally high around Outer Hebrides.

Shetland Isles.
24 hour forecast:
Wind: northwest backing south 6, decreasing 3 or 4 for a time overnight, later veering westerly 6 or 7.
Weather: rain spreading from west overnight followed by showers.
Visibility: moderate or good.
Sea State: rough or very rough.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Wind: west backing southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7.
Weather: showers.
Visibility: good.
Sea State: rough or very rough.

Outlook for all UK Inshore Waters for following 3 days: Remaining unsettled with strong winds and gales at times in all areas. Severe gales are expected on Sunday night, Monday and Tuesday particularly in northern and western areas.

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
