Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1200 UTC Friday 04 June to 1200 UTC Saturday 05 June 2021

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure gradually displaces a humid and potentially thundery airmass to the east of the United Kingdom tonight. Weak fronts will encroach from off the Atlantic and become the focus for some showers into the weekend.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5 at first near Cape Wrath and Rattray Head, otherwise variable 2 to 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north, becoming smooth or slight later in east.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming east or northeast 4 or 5 later for a time.

Smooth or slight, becoming mainly moderate west and north of Orkney.

Showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 4 or 5, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Slight, occasionally smooth later.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mostly south or southeast at first, 3 or 4, becoming west 4 or 5 for a time later.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Slight, becoming smooth later.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly south or southeast at first, 2 to 4.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Fair.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain at first, fog patches for a time later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southeast 3 or 4 for a time.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northwesterly, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times becoming variable 3 or less later in south.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or thundery showers until later, fog patches later in north.

Moderate or poor, becoming moderate or good later, occasionally very poor later in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first.

Smooth or slight, becoming smooth.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor later.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly, backing southwesterly later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Rain or thundery showers until later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches at first then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly south or southwest at first, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4 later, occasionally 5 later in far west.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far west.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 2 to

4 later.

Mainly moderate west of the Lizard peninsula, otherwise smooth or slight.
Occasional rain or drizzle, fog banks developing.
Good, becoming moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4 in west, occasionally 5 later in west, otherwise variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later in west.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 4 or 5 at first in west, otherwise variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first.

Moderate in west, otherwise smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle, fog banks developing.

Good, becoming moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4 in Cardigan Bay, otherwise south or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near St Davids Head and Holyhead.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later near St Davids Head.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first near St Davids Head.

Fair then occasional rain or drizzle, fog patches for a time.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 to 5 north of Morecambe Bay, otherwise variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 to 5 at first north of Morecambe Bay, otherwise variable, becoming northwesterly later, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional drizzle.

Good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in west.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in west.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in west, veering northerly or northwesterly 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight.
Occasional drizzle with fog patches, becoming fair later.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, becoming moderate or good later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast, 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 for a time.
Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight except in northwest.
Occasional rain or showers, mainly in west.
Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.
Fog patches at first in east, thundery showers, becoming fair later.
Good to poor, occasionally very poor at first in east, becoming good later.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly, 3 to 5.
Slight, occasionally smooth in Firth of Clyde.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near Mull of Kintyre.
Occasional rain or showers with fog patches, becoming fair later.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, becoming good later.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

South 3 to 5.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 to 5, veering west or southwest 2 to 4.
Slight or moderate.
Showers at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in south.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South becoming variable, then southwest later, 3 or 4.
Smooth or slight.
Occasional rain or showers until later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor until later.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest, 3 to 5.

Moderate, occasionally slight near Cape Wrath.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South becoming variable, then southwest later, 3 or 4.
Moderate.
Occasional rain or showers until later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor until later.
