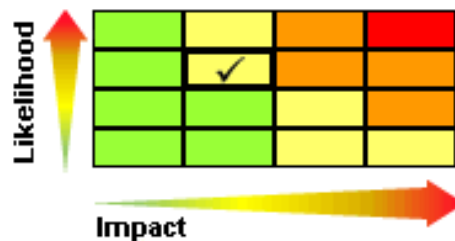
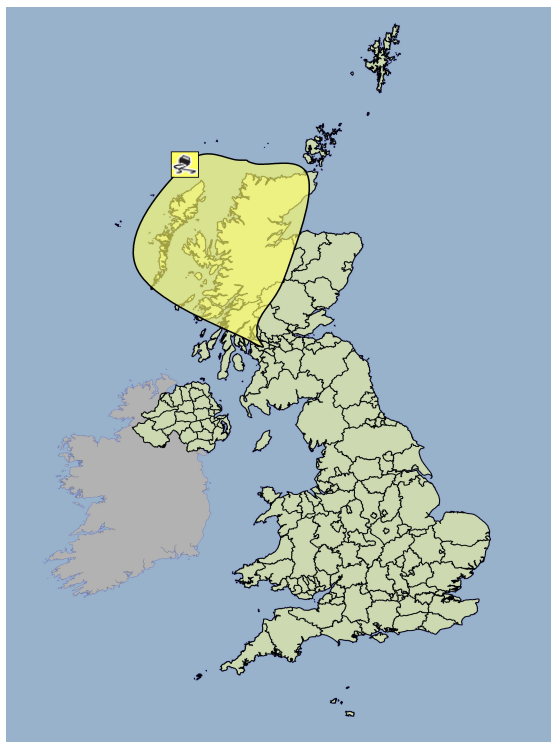


## National Severe Weather Warning Service



### Chief Forecasters Assessment

Showers, with slight accumulations of snow above about 300 m, are falling onto sub zero surfaces, leading to icy patches.
