Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0600 UTC Friday 01 June to 0600 UTC Saturday 02 June 2018

General Situation

A slack pressure pattern will continue to affect the British Isles during the next 24 hours. Locally heavy and thundery showers will move across some of the inshore waters areas at times, and there will also be some more areas of sea fog, especially near eastern coasts.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, thundery showers for a time.

Moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly northeast 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, but extensive fog for a time.

Moderate to very poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, but extensive fog for a time.

Moderate to very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, becoming north or northeast later, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers, fog banks, perhaps extensive fog later.

Moderate to very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Fog banks.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming north or northwest 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, showers developing.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less becoming northwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks, thundery showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, thundery showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 or 2 becoming southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in east.

Slight, occasionally smooth at first.

Fog banks until later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, but becoming good at times later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming southwest 4 or 5, then veering west 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth at first.

Fog banks at first, thundery showers for a time.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, then becoming moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West backing southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable 3 or less later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in east.

Slight, occasionally moderate near the Isles of Scilly.

Fog patches and showers at first, thundery in east, becoming fair later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, then becoming good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing southeast, then northeast later, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near the Isles of Scilly.

Fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 or 2 becoming west or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in Bristol Channel.

Slight.

Thundery showers and fog patches until later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, but becoming good later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest becoming variable, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Slight, occasionally smooth in north.

Fair.

Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 1 or 2 becoming south or southwest 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers at first, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less from Cardigan Bay southwards.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches then fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first, becoming good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming west or southwest, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in Solway Firth, then becoming variable 1 or 2 later.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Fog patches then mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first, becoming good.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming mainly southwest, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, then banks later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 3 or 4 becoming variable 3 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Fog banks then fair.

Moderate to very poor, becoming good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers for a time, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Thundery showers, fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable, but becoming mainly southerly in North Channel, 3 or less, increasing

4 at times.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery showers for a time, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery showers, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first.
Slight, occasionally smooth later.
Thundery showers for a time, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery showers, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 at first.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery showers for a time in east, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less becoming north or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.
Smooth or slight.
Thundery showers in east, fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.
Slight or moderate at first to the west of the Outer Hebrides, otherwise slight.
Fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less becoming north or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.
Slight.
Fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland
Valid Friday 01 Jun 2018 at 0600 UTC until Friday 01 Jun 2018 at 1800 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A complex but slack area of low pressure covers mainland Scotland with a very moist airmass over Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

East or southeast 2 or 3.

Mainly slight.

Fog banks, becoming mainly fair in east later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, becoming mainly good in east later.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Friday 01 Jun until 0600 UTC on Saturday 02 Jun:

Variable 2 or 3.

Slight.

Fog banks, but mainly fair in east at first.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor, but mainly good in east at first.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Westerly 3 to 5, becoming northwest to north 2 to 4 near the brittany coast this afternoon, then generally westerly 2 to 4 overnight.

Slight, locally moderate.

Risk of a shower at first fog banks, clearing for a time this afternoon and evening.

Moderate to very poor, occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest or variable 1 to 3, becoming north to northeast 2 to 4 in the afternoon, veering easterly in the evening.

Smooth or slight, with a low swell.

Mist or fog patches.

Good, locally poor or very poor.

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
