Forecast for Thursday 06 Oct 2022

Weather: Showers or longer outbreaks of rain overnight, heavy and times with a small risk of thunderstorms. Bright spells and occasional heavy showers during daylight hours, the showers then merging into longer outbreaks of heavy rain in the evening. Summit gales, buffeting and severe wind chill.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 60% falling 10% during the evening.

Low cloud and visibility: Occasional or extensive cloud, base around 900 to 1200m, but lowering to around 600m in showers. Becoming extensive 600m or less in the evening. Visibility moderate or poor in rain or showers, occasionally very poor at height. Otherwise very good.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Challenging and changeable conditions expected. Storm force winds possible over the Cairngorms Plateau, gusts 70mph or more.

Forecast for Friday 07 Oct 2022

Weather: Heavy overnight rain soon clearing. Then bright spells and occasional heavy showers during daylight hours, the risk of hail and the odd thunderstorm, and wintry over the highest summits. Strong to gale force winds at height with a severe wind chill.

Maximum wind: West or Southwest 35mph gusting 50mph.

Chance of cloud-free hill tops above 800m: 60%

Low cloud and visibility: Occasional or extensive cloud, base 900 to 1200m, lowering to around 600m in showers. Visibility very good falling moderate or poor in showers, occasionally very poor at height.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 6 to 13 Celsius
At 800m: Plus 4 Celsius
Freezing level: 1200 to 1400m
