General Situation

A deep area of low pressure will move northeastwards to the north of Scotland overnight bringing strong winds all gales to most parts. Winds will ease as the low moves away during Sunday. An area of low pressure is expected to develop to the south of the United Kingdom during Sunday and Monday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 until later.

Rough or very rough, occasionally high until later in north.

Showers.

Good.

Southerly 5 to 7, backing southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough,.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 5 to 7, backing southeast 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Occasional rain until later.

Good, occasionally moderate until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 until later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly backing southeasterly later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate occasionally rough until later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

Southerly or southwesterly 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5, backing southeasterly 5 or 6 later, occasionally 7 in south.

Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first in south, decreasing 4 at times.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5, backing southeast 5 or 6 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.
Occasional rain, showers later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time and again later.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain, fair later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor until later.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwest 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5, backing southeast 5 or 6 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.
Occasional rain at first and again later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 5 or 6.
Moderate.
Occasional rain, fair later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor until later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
South or southwest, backing southeast later, 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough for a time in north, becoming slight or moderate later.
Rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North

Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly, backing southeasterly later, 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Very rough or high, becoming moderate or rough later.

South 4 or 5, becoming cyclonic then southeast later, 5 or 6.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 7 or gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time, decreasing 5 or 6 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough later.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, becoming southeast 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers, then occasional rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 7 or gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time, decreasing 5 or 6 later.

High or very high, becoming very rough or high, becoming rough or very rough later.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 5 or 6, becoming variable 3 or 4, becoming southeast 5 or 6 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.

Showers, then occasional rain.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A deep Atlantic low will be slow moving to the south of Iceland, maintaining the

strong southerly airstream. Associated cold front will move away from the Shetland Waters in the early hours.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Southerly severe gale force 9 decreasing gale force 8 imminent, issued 0343 Saturday 03 November 2018.

South 6 to gale 8.

Rough or very rough, becoming high in north and west.

Rain or showers at first then fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Sunday 04 Nov until 0000 UTC on Monday 05 Nov:

South 7 or gale 8 decreasing 5 or 6 later.

Very rough, occasionally high in north and west, becoming rough to very rough later.

Mainly fair, showers in far west.

Mainly good, occasionally moderate in far west.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 5 to 6, occasionally 7 mid-channel until dawn, backing southeast during the morning, decreasing 4 to 5, occasionally 6 in the afternoon.

Moderate to rather rough, locally rough in the northwest until mid-morning.

Occasional rain in the north and west, clearing by afternoon.

Good, occasionally moderate in rain.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 4 to 5, veering south 3 to 4 in the evening.

Slight to moderate, with a moderate swell decreasing.

Risk of rain in the west of the area later.

Good, locally moderate in any rain.
