Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Rain over northeast Scotland will die away, leaving variable cloud and bright spells, although the Highland Glens may remain foggy. Rain over many parts of England and Wales should clear away northwestwards by or during the afternoon. Cloudy skies to follow, although Northern Ireland and some western/southern areas may see a few bright or sunny spells. Temperatures, near normal to mild.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Windy in the far north and far south with patchy rain/drizzle. Sunny spells developing elsewhere after the clearance of a sharp frost and fog. Cold under persisting fog and feeling cold in the windier south.
