### Forecast for Sunday 06 Jun 2021

**Weather:** Cloudy with the odd spot of drizzle in the early hours. The cloud breaking up soon after dawn and then remaining cloud burning off before mid morning. Good sunny spells through the day, especially over western fells and towards the west coast where it should be unbroken. Some scattered clouds bubbling up over central and eastern fells at times. After some evening sunshine, cloud and the odd shower may arrive around midnight.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** 10% until shortly after dawn, then rising to more than 95% by mid morning.

**Visibility:** Patches of poor visibility at lower levels overnight due to drizzle, and very poor visibility above the cloud line which will be down to 450m in places. Once this burns off the remaining very good for the rest of the day.

**Meteorologist's View**

**Forecast for Monday 07 Jun 2021**

**Weather:** Cloudy overnight and in the morning with occasional rain. Then becoming drier and brighter from the west with sunny intervals developing during the afternoon.

**Maximum wind:** Southeast 10-15mph veering southwest in the afternoon.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m:** 30% in morning rising to 80% in the afternoon.

**Visibility:** Mostly good, but moderate in any morning rain, and very poor above the cloud line which is likely to be down to 500-700m in the morning before lifting above tops.

**Temperature:** **Valleys:** Plus 11 Celsius peaking at Plus 19 Celsius in the afternoon.

**At 800m:** Plus 8 Celsius rising to Plus 12 Celsius

**Freezing level:** Above the summits.
