General Situation

High pressure will continue to build to the north of the United Kingdom during the next 48 hours, bringing a northerly or northeasterly flow to many areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northwesterly 3 or 4, veering easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in northwest.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate in north.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in northwest.

Slight or moderate, becoming rough at times towards Rattray Head.

Fair.

Good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming north or northeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fog patches, becoming mainly fair.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming mainly good.

North or northeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough towards Rattray Head.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

Moderate to very poor, occasionally good in south.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate, occasionally very poor, becoming good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in east.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in east.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 offshore.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate offshore.

Showers later, otherwise mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast, becoming variable for a time, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate offshore.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast, becoming variable for a time, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate west of Start Point, otherwise smooth or slight.

Showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 around headlands.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

North or northeast, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Showers later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast, becoming variable at times, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

North or northeast 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

Variable becoming easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 later in north.

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 in south.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times, becoming northeasterly 5 later in north.

Smooth or slight.

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 at times in south.

Variable, mainly east or southeast, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north.

Smooth in shelter, otherwise slight, occasionally moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 in south.

Smooth in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later in north.

Slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 in south.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will cover Shetland and surrounding waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Northerly or northwesterly 3 or 4 veering northeasterly 4 or 5

Slight or moderate

Mainly fair, occasional sea fog patches a first in south

Good, occasionally very poor at first in south

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 04 Jun until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 05 Jun:

Northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east

Slight or moderate

Fair

Good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming northeast 4 to 5 by dawn, increasing 6 at times by mid-morning.

Slight to moderate, perhaps locally rather rough.

Isolated thundery showers mist or fog patches mainly in the north of the area by early Monday morning.

Good, locally moderate to poor in showers and poor or very poor in mist or fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeasterly 4 to 5, increasing 6 at times.

Slight to moderate, perhaps locally rather rough, with a low swell.

Scattered thundery showers risk of mist or fog patches at times, mainly in the north of the area.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor, perhaps very poor.

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
