Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Scotland, northern and eastern England will be rather cloudy with
showers or longer spells of rain, some heavy with local thunder.
Further south and west, there will be sunny spells and just a few
showers with much of Wales and southwest England remaining dry. It
will feel warm in sunshine in the west, but it will become
increasingly windy, especially across eastern parts of England later
with a risk of gales near the North Sea coast.

Tonight, southwestern areas will be dry. Elsewhere, it will be cloudy
with rain or showers, though many places should become dry by
morning. It will remain windy.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Some showers in the east on Thursday, otherwise dry and quite warm
with some sunshine.
