#### General Situation

A ridge of high pressure will dominate the weather across most of the British Isles during Saturday, although a west to southwesterly airflow will continue to bring cloud and some showery rain to northwestern Scotland.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first, increasing 6 at times later. Slight or moderate to the west and north of Orkney, but elsewhere smooth or slight.

Showers, then drizzle later in north.

Good, occasionally poor later in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, becoming variable 3 at times later.

Slight or moderate to the west and north of Orkney, but elsewhere smooth or slight.

Drizzle at times, then rain later.

Good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or 4, becoming westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5 in south.

Slight, occasionally smooth in north.

Showers then fair.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in south, becoming variable 2 at times in north.

Slight, occasionally smooth in north.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West backing south or southeast, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

North becoming variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

#### Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

West or northwest becoming variable, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Slight.  
Fog patches.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable, becoming west or northwest later, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.  
Slight.  
Fair.  
Good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or less, occasionally 4 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fog patches until later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor until later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southwest 3 or 4 later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Fair.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway  
24 hour forecast:  
Northwest backing west or southwest, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in Solway Firth, decreasing 2 at times elsewhere.  
Smooth or slight.

Variable, but mainly southwesterly in north, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Isle of Man  
24 hour forecast:  
North or northwest becoming variable mainly southwest, 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.  
Smooth or slight.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough  
24 hour forecast:  
Variable 3 or less, increasing 4 at times.

Showers for a time in north.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Variable 3 or less, becoming mainly south 3 or 4 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in far north.  
Mainly fair.  
Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Showers for a time.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly northwesterly, becoming southerly later, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing south 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Drizzle at times, then rain later in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later in north.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first.

Slight.

Showers, then drizzle later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing south 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Slight or moderate.

Drizzle, then rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first, then increasing 6 at times in north.

Slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers, then drizzle later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest backing south 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Moderate throughout to the west of the Outer Hebrides, but elsewhere slight or moderate.

Drizzle, then rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A showery west to southwesterly flow covers Shetland waters.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in the west  
Slight, becoming moderate in the west  
Showers  
Moderate or good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Saturday 04 Aug until 0000 UTC on Sunday 05 Aug:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 or 6, occasionally 4 in the east at first  
Slight in the south and east, moderate in the north and west  
Showers, dying out later  
Mainly good

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northerly 3 or 4, perhaps locally 5 in the southeast of the area and variable 1 to 3 mid channel on Saturday afternoon, then veering northerly or northeasterly by midnight.

Smooth or slight.

Some mist and fog patches at times until midday.

Moderate or good, locally poor or very poor in mist or fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

North or northeast 2 to 4, veering east or northeast by Sunday morning.

Slight, with a low swell in the west of the area.

Risk of some mist or fog patches at times.

Good, perhaps moderate to very poor in any mist or fog.

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
