

Bands of heavy, thundery showers will bring a chance of flooding in southwest England on Friday and Saturday

What to expect

- Flooding of a few homes and business is likely
- Bus and train services probably affected with journey times taking longer
- Spray and flooding on roads probably making journey times longer

Further details

Bands of heavy, at times thundery, showers are expected to affect parts of southwest England from Friday morning until later on Saturday. Whilst most areas will see a rather wet spell, not everywhere will see the heaviest downpours. Where they do occur, 20-40 mm may fall in 6-12 hours, with perhaps around 50 mm falling in 24 hours - most likely across southeast-facing coasts and moors of Devon and Cornwall. Showers may also contain small hail at times.
