Forecast valid from 06:00 on Saturday 07 Aug 2021 until 23:59 on Sunday 08 Aug 2021

Forecast Issued on Saturday 07 Aug 2021 at 03:48

**Confidence:** High for unsettled conditions dominating this weekend, with showers and some longer spells of rain, some heavy and thundery. A trend towards more settled conditions by Tuesday.

**Headline for Saturday 07 Aug 2021:** Outbreaks of rain and drizzle will be replaced by showers, these heavy at times and also probably thundery. The showers may merge into longer spells of rain later.

### Forecast for Saturday 07 Aug 2021

**Weather:** Cloudy with outbreaks of light rain or drizzle this morning, replaced by some brighter intervals but also scattered heavy showers this afternoon. Some showers will be thundery with a chance of hail, merging into longer spells of rain later, especially this evening.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 600m:** 20% across the south at first and 60% across the north of the park, becoming generally 90% by late morning but cloud bases lowering to 600m in more prolonged and heavier showers.

**Visibility:** Moderate or good with near-by hills visible at first below the cloud, and with very limited visibility within the hill fog. Also visibility becoming curtailed, with only immediate hills visible, within the heaviest showers.

**Meteorologist's View**

Strong and gusty winds across summits, with quite chilly conditions in heavy showers. Hail and lightning likely to be a hazard. Note change a slight in wind direction through today.

**Forecast for Sunday 08 Aug 2021**

**Weather:** A showery and largely cloudy start to Sunday, some of the showers still occasionally heavy. Sunday morning further showers will come along, often heavy and probably becoming thundery with hail. Brightening for the afternoon with current indications for drier conditions developing as showers become isolated and lighter, with sunny spells. Mainly dry conditions with a chance of a few showers for the evening with lighter winds.

**Maximum wind:** Westerly or southwesterly 20-25mph with gusts around 40mph.

**Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 600m:** 0-20% for much of the morning becoming 90-100% during the afternoon as brighter weather develops.

**Visibility:** Moderate or poor for much of the morning with only near-by hills visible beneath the cloud and very limited visibility within the hill fog, becoming moderate or good in afternoon, perhaps very good by Sunday evening.

**Temperature:** **Valleys:** Plus 11 degrees Celsius becoming Plus 19 degrees Celsius.  
**At 600m:** Plus 10 degrees Celsius becoming Plus 12 degrees Celsius.  
**Freezing level:** Well above the summits.
