Forecast for Saturday 09 Oct 2021

Weather: A rather cloudy day, with the additional risk of some valley mist and fog early and late, perhaps coupled with the odd spot of drizzle in places. Cloud should lift through the morning, perhaps allowing some limited bright or sunny intervals into the afternoon before thicker cloud arrives late in the day, ahead of a damp evening.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 600m: 10% at first becoming 60% through morning, dropping to near nil in the evening.

Visibility: Patchy cloud and valley mist and fog patches down to low slopes at first, lifting during the morning. Otherwise, good visibility through most of the day but becoming very poor in the evening with extensive cloud developing down to low slopes again.

Forecast for Sunday 10 Oct 2021

Weather: Low cloud and patchy rain clearing overnight. A dry day with plenty of sunshine in the morning, this becoming a little hazy in the afternoon.

Maximum wind: Northwest 10-15mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 600m: 10% at midnight but becoming 95% by dawn.

Visibility: Excellent air clarity with clear views of distant hills and moors.

Temperature: **Valleys:** Plus 9C rising to 13 or 14C.
At 600m: Plus 8C rising to 10 or 11C.
Freezing level: Well above summits.
