General Situation

Low pressure will remain slow moving to the south of Iceland, as a small area of low pressure moves northeastwards past northwestern Scotland. A cold front will move quickly eastwards across the United Kingdom on Sunday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 6 to gale 8, veering south or southwest 5 or 6.

Slight in Moray Firth, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers, rain at first.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, becoming cyclonic, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate in east, moderate or rough in north.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 6 to gale 8, veering southwest 5 or 6.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers, rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, becoming cyclonic, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers, rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 6 to gale 8, veering southwest 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Showers, rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 for a time.

Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.

Fair then rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 for a time, decreasing 4 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate for a time.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 6 to gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Fair then rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Squally showers, rain and drizzle at first.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 for a time.

Rough or very rough, occasionally moderate in lyme bay.

Squally showers, rain at first.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5, then veering west later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate in lyme bay.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times.

Very rough becoming rough.

Squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first, veering west 4 later.

Moderate or rough.

Thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough.

Squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, veering west 4 later.

Moderate or rough.

Thunderly showers.

Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.

Slight in Liverpool Bay, otherwise moderate or rough.

Squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, increasing 7 for a time, then veering west later.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6.

Moderate, occasionally rough at first.

Mainly fair.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 or 6, veering west 4 later.

Mainly moderate.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest, becoming cyclonic, 5 to 7, then becoming northwest later.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 or 6, increasing 7 at times.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, squally later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly, becoming cyclonic, 5 to 7, then becoming northwesterly later.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.
Showers, rain for a time.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7, backing south 5 later.

Moderate or rough.

Squally showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South, becoming cyclonic, 5 or 6, then becoming north later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers, rain for a time.

Good, occasionally moderate.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 4 or 5, backing southwest 5 to 7, then backing south 5 or 6 later.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South, becoming cyclonic, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, then becoming north or northeast later.

Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.

Showers.

Good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 4 or 5, backing southwest 5 to 7, then backing south 5 or 6 later.

Rough.

Squally showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South, becoming cyclonic, 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times, then becoming north or northeast later.

Rough, occasionally very rough in south.

Showers.

Good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A large depression will remain south of Iceland, with a frontal trough moving northeast across Shetland early on Sunday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil at time of issue.

Southeast 5 to 7 veering southwest 5 or 6.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough at first in west.

Rain at first, showers later.

Moderate or good becoming mainly good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Sunday 02 Nov until 0000 UTC on Monday 03

Nov:

Southwest 5 or 6.

Moderate or rough.

Showers clearing later.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South to southwest 6 to 7, locally gale 8, veering southwest to west late Sunday morning and decreasing 4 to 6, locally 7 in the north late evening.

Rather rough to rough, decreasing early afternoon, moderate in the south to rather rough in the north.

Rain, by the morning, locally heavy, then scattered showers in the afternoon and evening.

Good, locally moderate to poor in rain or showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to southwest 5 to 6, locally 7 at times overnight, decreasing 3 to 4 by afternoon but gusty near showers.

Moderate to rough, becoming slight to moderate in the afternoon.

Rain or scattered showers, heavy at times.

Good, locally moderate to poor in rain or showers.

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
