Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore from 1200 UTC to 1200 UTC

General Situation

A deepening area of low pressure will cross the United Kingdom today, moving out into the North Sea overnight.

From Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 or 6, backing northeast 6 to gale 8, then backing northwest.

Moderate becoming rough or very rough.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 6 to gale 8, backing southeast later.

Rough, occasionally very rough at first.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick on Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic, then southwest 7 to severe gale 9.

Moderate becoming rough.

Rain.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7, backing south later.

Rough becoming moderate.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick on Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast veering southwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time.

Moderate becoming rough.

Rain then squally showers.

Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 6 to gale 8, decreasing 5 to 7, backing south later.

Rough becoming moderate.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

Southeast veering southwest 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough later.

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, backing southerly later.
Moderate, occasionally rough at first.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly veering southwesterly 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 4 or 5 later.
Moderate becoming rough.
Rain then squally showers.
Moderate or poor occasionally good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7.
Moderate, occasionally rough at first.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 at first, veering
northwesterly 5 to 7 later.
Rough.
Squally showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5 for a time.
Moderate or rough.
Rain or showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 6 to gale 8 occasionally severe gale 9 for a time, decreasing
5 or 6 later.
Rough or very rough.
Squally showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 or 6, increasing 6 to gale 8 later.
Rough or very rough.
Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or good occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time, decreasing
5 or 6 later.
Rough or very rough.
Squally showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 5 or 6, increasing 6 to gale 8 later.
Rough, but very rough in west.

Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Ormes Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West or northwest 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time, decreasing 5 or 6 later.
Moderate becoming rough.
Squally showers.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or southwest 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8 later.
Moderate or rough.
Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Ormes Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic becoming westerly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 for a time, decreasing 5 to 7 later.
Moderate becoming rough.
Rain then squally showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Westerly 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.
Moderate or rough.
Rain or squally showers.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Cyclonic becoming west 7 to severe gale 9, decreasing 5 to 7 later.
Rough or very rough.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

Moderate becoming rough.
Rain then squally showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

West or southwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.
Rough.
Rain or squally showers.
Good becoming moderate or poor later.

The Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and the North Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northeast backing northwest 5 to 7, increasing 7 to severe gale 9 for a time.
Rough or very rough.
Rain then squally showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or southwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8 later.
Rough.
Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northeast backing northwest 5 to 7, increasing 7 to severe gale 9 for a time.
Rough, occasionally very rough.
Rain.
Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West or southwest 5 to 7.
Rough.
Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath including the Outer Hebrides - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Easterly 4 or 5, backing northwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in south.
Rough, occasionally very rough in west.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Westerly or northwesterly 6 to gale 8, backing southeasterly for a time.
Rough, occasionally very rough in west.
Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or good occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Easterly 4 or 5, backing northwesterly 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in south.
Moderate, occasionally rough in far north and far south.
Occasional rain.
Moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Westerly or northwesterly 6 to gale 8, backing southeasterly for a time.
Moderate, occasionally rough in far north and far south.
Rain or squally showers.
Moderate or good occasionally poor.

The Channel Islands - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West 6 or 7 with gusts to 45kt, decreasing 5 or 6 late afternoon, backing southwest for a time
overnight, increasing 6 to gale 8, veering northwest by morning, decreasing 5 or 6 later.
Rough or very rough.
Occasional showers risk of thunder.
Good except in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest 5 or 6 backing southwest in the afternoon, veering west increasing 6 to gale 8 overnight.
Rough or very rough.
Showers dying out rain or drizzle from early evening.
Good except in showers becoming moderate to poor in rain.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A developing depression will move northeast then north over the UK, expected close to Shetland by midday Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southeasterly gale 8 increasing severe gale 9 later, issued at 31/2145

Southeast 5 to 7 increasing gale 8 or severe gale 9 then backing east.
Rough building very rough.
Rain.
Good becoming moderate or poor.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Monday 02 Nov until 1200 UTC on Monday 02 Nov:
East becoming cyclonic 7 to severe gale 9.
Very rough.
Rain.
Moderate or poor.

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
