Weather: A fine dry start to the week with good bright and sunny spells appearing, though these probably more limited across Sutherland through the morning where the odd drizzly shower may appear at first.

Visibility: Generally very good, but very poor in cloud where bases lower 700-1000m chiefly during the morning and across Sutherland.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Risk of sunburn in the strong afternoon sunshine.

Forecast for Tuesday 03 Aug 2021

Weather: Mostly dry with further bright and sunny spells, however a touch cloudier than Monday, particularly during the afternoon as some isolated showers bubble up.

Maximum wind: South to southwest around 10mph.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 90%

Visibility: Generally very good, but very poor where cloud bases lower to 700-1000m, mainly in the afternoon, particularly in the few showers.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 5 Celsius increasing 20 Celsius during the afternoon
At 800m: Plus 7 Celsius increasing 11 Celsius during the afternoon
Freezing level: Above all summits
