General Situation

A weak ridge of high pressure developing over the United Kingdom today will move away east to be followed by a trough of low pressure moving across from the west later on Tuesday and during Wednesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in far northwest at first, backing southeasterly 3 or 4.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 or 4 increasing 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 becoming variable then southeast 2 or 3, occasionally 4.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

Mainly south or southwest, 2 or 3 increasing 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west.

Showers.

Good.

South or southwest, backing southeast for a time, then veering west or southwest later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6.

Slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming south or southeast 4 or 5.

Mainly slight.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast becoming cyclonic then west or southwest, 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight.

Showers later.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast becoming cyclonic 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Mainly slight.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Southwest backing south or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Showers, rain for a time.

Good, becoming moderate or poor at times.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

South or southwest 2 or 3, occasionally 4, backing southeast 4 or 5.

Mainly slight.

Southeast, becoming cyclonic later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

Southerly or southwesterly 2 or 3, occasionally 4, backing southeasterly 4 or 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate in west at first.

Southeast, becoming cyclonic later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, backing southeasterly 2 or 3, increasing 4 or 5 in south later.
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.
Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, backing southeasterly 2 or 3, increasing 4 or 5 in south later.

Occasional rain or showers.
Moderate or good.

East or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5.
Slight or moderate.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Low near Faroe will continue drifting north with ridge of high pressure gradually building over Shetland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southeasterly veering southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in northeast.
Slight or moderate.
Isolated showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0000 UTC on Tuesday 05 Aug until 1200 UTC on Tuesday 05 Aug:
Southwest, veering west, 4 or 5, backing south or southwest 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate.
Isolated showers at first.
Good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 2 to 3, locally variable 1 to 3 jersey southwards, becoming southerly overnight and increasing 3 to 4 by morning.
Smooth or slight.
Isolated showers.
Very good, locally moderate in showers.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 3 to 4, veering southwest to west increasing 4 to 5 overnight, decreasing 2 to 4 Wednesday morning.
Slight becoming mainly moderate overnight.
Isolated showers rain from mid-evening, clearing Wednesday morning.
Good, locally moderate to poor in rain.

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
