Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Monday 04 May to 1800 UTC Tuesday 05 May 2020

General Situation

A large area of high pressure will drift southeast across Scotland overnight to become centred across the western North Sea by Tuesday, where it will remain for the next few days. This will bring a period of settled weather to most areas, however active fronts will bring rain and gales to waters in the far south and far southwest.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable, mainly northeast at first, 2 to 4.

Smooth or slight.

Westerly until later in north, otherwise variable, 2 to 4.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Moderate, occasionally rough in west.
Rain later in west.
Good, occasionally poor later in west.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or northeasterly 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.
Moderate becoming slight.

Showers at first in west.
Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7, occasionally gale 8 for a time.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.
Fair then rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 6 or 7, decreasing 4 or 5, occasionally 3 later.
Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate.

Showers at first.
Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly, 4 or 5 at first in far east, otherwise 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in west.
Slight or moderate at first in east, otherwise moderate or rough.
Mainly fair then rain or thundery showers.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5.
Moderate, occasionally rough at first, then becoming slight later in east.
Occasional rain, fog patches in west.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in west.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 4 or 5, increasing 6 to gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 in south.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough for a time in west.

Fair, then occasional rain.
Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, then decreasing 4 at times later.
Slight or moderate, becoming mainly smooth later in Bristol Channel.
Rain at times.
Moderate or good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 or 7 for a time.
Slight or moderate.
Rain for a time near St Davids Head.
Good, occasionally moderate for a time near St Davids Head.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East 4 to 6, becoming variable 3 at times.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate offshore and in exposure.
Mainly fair.
Good.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Easterly or northeasterly 4 to 6, becoming variable 3 or less later in far north.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate offshore and in exposure.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less at first in far north, otherwise easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south, backing northeasterly 3 or 4 later.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first offshore and in exposure.
Fair.
Good.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northeast veering east, 4 or 5 occasionally 6 for a time.
Slight or moderate.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East or southeast 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Northeasterly, veering easterly or southeasterly, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in south, becoming variable 3 at times in North Channel.
Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate in south.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less at first in North Channel, otherwise easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5.
Smooth or slight until later in north, otherwise slight or moderate.
Fair.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly veering easterly, 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in the North Channel.

Fair.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming southeasterly 4 or 5 in North Channel.

Smooth or slight.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

Northeast 3 or 4, veering southeast 4 or 5, then becoming variable 2 to 4 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest.

Variable 2 to 4, becoming southeasterly 4 or 5 in far south and far west.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

An area of high pressure over Shetland Waters on Monday evening will move south over the North Sea on Tuesday.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East to northeast 4 to 6, increasing 7 at times from mid evening to midday,
occasionally gale 8 from midnight until dawn, decreasing 3 at times later in the
far south of the area.

Moderate to rather rough, becoming rough in the north by midnight, then becoming
slight jersey southeastwards after dawn tomorrow.

Rain at times, spreading in from the southwest after dusk, sometimes heavy,
perhaps thundery showers, perhaps heavy and thundery, following northeastwards
between dawn and early afternoon.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly 4 to 6, becoming variable 2 to 4 by midnight.

Rather rough to rough at first in the north, otherwise slight to moderate.

Isolated showers.
