Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 1800 UTC Sunday 02 August to 1800 UTC Monday 03 August 2020

General Situation

A showery, predominantly westerly airstream will cover the United Kingdom for the rest of Sunday and on Monday. Atlantic weather fronts will make inroads into northern and western areas during Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable at first in east, otherwise westerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 in northwest.

Moderate or rough west and north of Orkney, otherwise slight, occasionally smooth.

Showers, perhaps thundery at first.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing southeast 4 to 6 later.

Moderate west and north of Orkney and later in far east, otherwise smooth or slight.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4 at first in north, otherwise westerly or southwesterly, 3 to 5. Smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery at first.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 3 to 5, backing south 4 to 6 later.

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate later.

Occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming west 3 to 5 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable becoming west or southwest, 3 or 4, then backing south 5 or 6 later.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain later.

Good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Variable, becoming northwest for a time, 3 or 4.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Showers, perhaps thundery at first in north.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth, occasionally slight.

Mainly fair.
Good.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Variable becoming northerly or northwesterly for a time, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming southerly 3 to 5 later.

Smooth, occasionally slight later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, veering northerly 3 or 4, then becoming variable later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first, then occasionally smooth.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming southwesterly 3 to 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, veering northwest 3 or 4 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first, then occasionally smooth.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest, backing southwest later, 3 to 5.

Slight, occasionally smooth until later.

Fair.

Good.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

West veering northwest, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first west of the Lizard.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest backing southwest later, 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later west of the Lizard.

Fair.

Good.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later in Bristol Channel.

Slight, occasionally moderate until later in west.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest, 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first in Bristol Channel, backing

southwest 4 to 6.
Slight, becoming moderate later.
Occasional drizzle later.
Good.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
Southwest veering northwest for a time, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.
Smooth or slight.
Showers at first.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, then increasing 6 or 7 later.
Smooth or slight, becoming moderate later.
Occasional rain or drizzle later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
West or northwest, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in Solway Firth.
Smooth or slight.
Showers until later.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
West backing southwest, 3 to 5, then increasing 6 or 7 later.
Smooth or slight, becoming mainly moderate later.
Occasional rain or drizzle later.
Good, occasionally poor later.

Isle of Man
24 hour forecast:
Southwest veering northwest for a time, 3 or 4.
Slight.
Showers at first.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 3 or 4, backing south 6 or 7 later.
Slight, becoming moderate or rough later.
Rain and drizzle later.
Good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough
24 hour forecast:
Variable, mainly west, 2 to 4.
Moderate in north, otherwise smooth or slight.
Showers until later.
Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or 4, becoming south or southwest, 4 to 6.
Mainly smooth until later in sheltered east, otherwise slight or moderate.
Fair then rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor for a time.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
24 hour forecast:
Westerly becoming variable at times in south, 3 or 4.
Slight or moderate near Mull of Kintyre, otherwise smooth or slight.
Showers until later.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable, mainly westerly, 3 or 4, becoming southerly 4 to 6.

Smooth or slight, becoming mainly moderate later.

Fair then rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor for a time.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

West 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, backing south 5 to 7, occasionally 4 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later near Tiree.

Fair then rain or drizzle at times.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later near Cape Wrath.

Moderate in far south and far north, otherwise smooth or slight.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near Cape Wrath, backing south 5 to 7.

Smooth or slight until later in central areas, otherwise moderate.

Showers, then rain or drizzle.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later near Cape Wrath.

Moderate or rough.

Showers.

Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near Cape Wrath, backing south 5 to 7.

Moderate, occasionally rough later.

Showers, then rain or drizzle.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Valid Sunday 02 Aug 2020 at 1800 UTC until Monday 03 Aug 2020 at 0600 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A rather unstable west to southwesterly airstream covers the area.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first

Moderate or rough, but slight east of Shetland

Showers

Mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Monday 03 Aug until 1800 UTC on Monday 03

Aug:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 for a time

Moderate or rough, but slight east of Shetland

Showers

Moderate or good

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

West to northwest 3 to 4, locally 5.

Slight, occasionally moderate, with a low swell.

Isolated showers, becoming more frequent after midnight, mainly in the south of the area, dying out through Monday morning.

Good, locally moderate until mid-morning.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northwest 4 to 5, decreasing 2 to 4 overnight, backing westerly Tuesday morning.

Slight, locally moderate, decreasing smooth or slight overnight, with a low swell.

Fair.
