General Situation

Pressure will remain low near Iceland and high over Europe, with a westerly or southwesterly air stream continuing to affect the United Kingdom.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
A large depression near Iceland will maintain a southwesterly airflow over Shetland.

Variable or east 2 to 3, becoming mainly southeast by dawn.
