General Situation

Pressure will remain high across the United Kingdom during the coming days,
bringing mainly settled conditions to all areas.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly south or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near Rattray Head.
Slight in Moray Firth, otherwise slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly south or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near Cape Wrath and
Rattray Head.

Slight in Moray Firth, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rain at times later.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, but becoming variable 2 in
Firth of Forth.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fair.

Good, occasionally poor.

South or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, but mainly variable 2 in Firth
of Forth.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fog patches later.

Southeast 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 2 or 3, occasionally 4 later.

Slight.

Fog patches later in far north, otherwise fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor later in far north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 or 4 backing northeast 2 or 3.

Slight.

Fog patches in far north, otherwise fair.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor in far north.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 2 at first, increasing 5 at times later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly backing northeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Fair.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 in west, increasing 6 at times later in east.

Slight or moderate.

Slight in east, slight or moderate in west.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

East 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times, but becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Slight or moderate.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable 2 or 3, becoming east or northeast 3 or 4 for a time.

Slight, occasionally moderate near land's end.

Fair.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable mainly east 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less for a time.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less becoming east or southeast 3 or 4.

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north, becoming variable 2 or 3 later.

Fog patches later in east.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Variable 3 or less, becoming southeasterly 3 or 4 in North Channel.
Moderate at first near the Mull of Kintyre, otherwise smooth or slight.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable 3 or less, becoming south or southeast 3 or 4 for a time.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point
24 hour forecast:
South or southeast 3 or 4, becoming variable 2 at times.
Slight or moderate.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first near islay and Tiree,
becoming variable 2 or 3 later.
Slight or moderate.
Rain or drizzle at times later.
Moderate or good.

The Minch
24 hour forecast:
Southerly 4 or 5 backing southeasterly 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times in south.
Slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast veering southwest, 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.
Slight, occasionally moderate in far south and far north.
Fair then rain or drizzle at times.
Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath
24 hour forecast:
Southerly 4 or 5 backing southeasterly 3 or 4, decreasing 2 at times in south.
Moderate or rough at first west of the Outer Hebrides, otherwise slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
South or southeast veering southwest, 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.
Moderate, becoming slight near Sutherland and between barra and canna.
Fair then rain or drizzle at times.
Moderate or good.

Shetland Isles

General Situation
Ridge of high pressure extends west from the Baltic across much of the UK.
However troughs will move over Shetland at times with a low moving into the Norwegian Sea.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southwesterly 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in northwest.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Wednesday 03 Sep until 0000 UTC on Thursday 04 Sep:

Southwesterly 4 or 5 backing southerly 4.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in northwest at first.

Fair.

Good.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to east 3 to 4, increasing 4 to 5 late afternoon.

Slight.

Mist and a risk of fog patches towards dawn, clearing by mid-morning.

Good, locally moderate to very poor in mist and fog.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast to east 3 to 4, locally north near french coasts in the afternoon.

Slight with a low swell.

Mist and a risk of fog patches around dawn, clearing by mid-morning.

Good, locally moderate to very poor around dawn.

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
