General Situation

A hugely complex area of low pressure will only drift very slowly southeastwards, and will maintain very unsettled and in places windy conditions throughout this forecast period.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 5 to 7.

Moderate at times in shelter, otherwise rough or very rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

East 3 or 4, backing northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

Variable, mainly southwest backing south later, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth at times in shelter.

Cyclonic, mainly southerly or southwesterly, veering northerly later, 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.

Westerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Westerly or southwesterly 5 to 7, becoming cyclonic 4 or 5 later.

Moderate, occasionally rough.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

Westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in west.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough near headlands and in west.

Showers.

Good occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly veering northerly later, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in west.

Occasional rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8, backing southwesterly 4 or 5 later.

Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough, mainly in southwest.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic, mainly southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in southwest, becoming

northerly 6 to gale 8 later.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in southwest.
Occasional rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

North becoming cyclonic 4 or 5.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in south.
Occasional rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 4 or 5, becoming north or northeast 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough, occasionally very rough for a time.
Occasional rain or thundery showers.
Good occasionally moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

North becoming cyclonic, then east later 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.
Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 or 5, backing northeast, then north later, 5 to 7.
Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough in west.
Occasional rain or showers.
Good occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

North or northwest veering northeast later, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.
Mainly slight.
Showers.
Mainly good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast 4 or 5, backing northeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.
Slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough later.
Showers.
Good occasionally moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.
Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.

Northeasterly backing northerly later, 5 to 7.
Smooth at first in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate, becoming moderate or rough.
Occasional rain or showers.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northerly or northeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate.
Showers.
Good.

Northeasterly backing northerly later, 5 to 7.
Smooth at times in shelter, otherwise slight or moderate, occasionally rough in North Channel.
Occasional rain or showers.

Variable 3 or 4 at first in south, otherwise northeasterly 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later in north.
Slight or moderate in southeast, moderate or rough in northwest.

Good.

Northeasterly backing northerly later, 5 to 7.
Moderate or rough.
Occasional rain or showers.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Low pressure persists across the southern North Sea and Central British Isles maintaining a strong northeasterly airstream across Shetland Waters

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Gale force 8 backing northeasterly imminent. Issued at 15:49 UTC on Saturday 02 November

2019.

Northeasterly 6 to gale 8, decreasing 4 or 5 in southeast.
Very rough, but rough southwest of Shetland.
Fair.
Good.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Sunday 03 Nov until 0600 UTC on Monday 04 Nov:
Northeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally 4 in southeast.

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 to 6, locally variable 1 to 4, backing north to northwest by dawn, then westerly 5 to 7 during the morning, increasing 7 to gale 8 for a time during the afternoon with gusts to 50kt, backing southwest 4 to 6 during the evening.

Moderate to rather rough, increasing rough to very rough by midday, decreasing rather rough to rough by midnight.

Occasional showers or longer periods of rain, locally heavy with the risk of thunder.

Moderate to good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West to southwest 5 to 6, occasionally 7 until afternoon.

Rather rough to rough, with moderate swell.
