Forecast for Wednesday 10 Mar 2021

Weather: Persistent rain and higher summit snow soon clearing after midnight. The rest of the morning period will see some clear or sunny periods and occasional snow showers. Clouding over the from the southwest in the afternoon with rain, preceded by snow above 600 to 800 metres, extending northeastwards by the end of the afternoon. Rain and higher summit snow continuing into the evening. Risk of blizzard conditions above 800 metres in the north of the area in the afternoon.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 30%, best chance in the morning.

Visibility: Poor in patchy cloud in the morning period down to 500 metres, this most prevalent across western and southern ranges. Low cloud becoming widespread in the afternoon down to 500 metres.

Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Gusts to 70 mph or possible on Lochnagar

Forecast for Thursday 11 Mar 2021

Weather: Some clear or sunny intervals and frequent, occasionally heavy showers of snow or hail. Low risk of an isolated thunderstorm. Cold and very windy at height.

Maximum wind: Gusts 50 to 60 mph on summits, and 75 mph over Lochnagar. Severe wind chill expected.

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 80%.

Visibility: Becoming poor in cloud down to 750 metres as snow showers pass by, some frequent periods of lower cloud possible across western ranges. Otherwise generally very good with good air clarity.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 1 rising to 7 Celsius
At 800m: Plus 2 falling to minus 2 Celsius
Freezing level: 1100 metres lowering to 500 metres
