#### General Situation

The unsettled weather will continue as another intense Atlantic depression approaches southwestern areas later on Tuesday.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 in far northeast at first, decreasing mainly 4 for a time in west.

Moderate or rough, but very rough at first in far northeast.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 6 to gale 8.

Moderate in shelter otherwise rough or very rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 to 7, veering south 4 or 5 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 6 to gale 8, veering south 5 or 6.

Rough or very rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 to 7, veering south 4 or 5 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 6 to gale 8 veering southwest 5 to 7.

Rough or very rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 5 to 7, veering south 4 or 5 for a time.

Moderate or rough.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 6 to gale 8 veering southwest 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 5 to 7, decreasing 4 or 5 for a time.

Slight in shelter otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 6 to gale 8 veering southwesterly 5 to 7.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly, veering southwesterly for a time, 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8.

Moderate or rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly 6 to gale 8 veering southwesterly 7 to severe gale 9.

Rough or very rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 6 to gale 8 backing south 7 to severe gale 9.

Slight or moderate in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming very rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, becoming moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering southwest 7 to severe gale 9.

Slight or moderate in shelter, otherwise rough or very rough, becoming high for a time in west.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or poor.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7 backing south gale 8 or severe gale 9.

Rough or very rough, becoming very rough or high.

Rain or squally showers.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering southwest gale 8 or severe gale 9.

Very rough or high, becoming high or very high for a time.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 5 to 7 backing south or southeast 7 to severe gale 9.

In far east, slight or moderate, otherwise moderate or rough becoming rough or very rough, then high in far southwest later.

Rain or squally showers.

Good, becoming moderate or poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South veering southwest 7 to severe gale 9.

Moderate or rough in far east, otherwise very rough or high, but becoming very high for a time in far southwest.  
Rain or squally showers.  
Moderate or poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6, backing southeast 7 to severe gale 9.

Slight in shelter at first, otherwise moderate or rough, becoming rough or very rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest 7 to severe gale 9.

Rough or very rough, but high for a time in far southwest.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 5 to 7 increasing 7 or gale 8 later.

Slight in shelter otherwise moderate or rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast veering southwest 6 to gale 8.

Slight or moderate in shelter, otherwise rough or very rough.

Rain or squally showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5 backing southeast 5 or 6, increasing 7 or gale 8, occasionally severe gale 9 later.

Moderate, becoming rough or very rough later.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 7 to severe gale 9, veering southwest 6 or 7 later.

Rough or very rough, becoming moderate or rough later.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6, backing southeast 7 to severe gale 9 later.

Slight in shelter, otherwise mainly moderate, becoming rough or very rough.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast 7 to severe gale 9 veering southwest 6 to gale 8.

Slight or moderate in shelter, otherwise rough or very rough, becoming mainly moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6, backing southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9 later.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise mainly moderate, becoming rough or very rough.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southeasterly 7 to severe gale 9 veering southwesterly 6 to gale 8.  
Slight or moderate in shelter, otherwise rough or very rough, becoming mainly moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or poor, occasionally good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6, backing east 7 or gale 8 later.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East 6 to gale 8 veering southwest 5 to 7.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough, but very rough at first in far west.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly backing easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6, increasing 7 in far south later.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Rain at first, then showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East becoming cyclonic 6 to gale 8.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate or rough.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly backing easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6, increasing 7 or gale 8 in far south later.  
Rough or very rough.  
Rain at first, then showers.  
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
East becoming cyclonic 6 to gale 8.  
Rough or very rough.  
Occasional rain.  
Moderate or good.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland  
Valid Tuesday 04 Feb 2014 at 0000 UTC until Tuesday 04 Feb 2014 at 1200 UTC

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
Ridge over Scandinavia extends into Norwegian Sea while deep low south of Iceland brings a trough north over Shetland Tuesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Southeasterly gale force 8 at time of issue.

Southeast 6 to gale 8.  
Rough or very rough.  
Rain or showers later.  
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Tuesday 04 Feb until 0000 UTC on Wednesday 05 Feb:  
Southeast veering south 6 or 7, perhaps gale 8 at first.  
Rough or very rough.  
Occasional rain or showers.  
Moderate or good.

Channel Islands - (SWW)  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest to south 4 to 5, locally 6 in the north, backing south to southeast by midday and increasing 6 to 7, further increasing gale 8 to severe gale 9 by evening with gusts to 60kt.  
Moderate to rather rough becoming rough to very rough by dusk.  
Scattered rain or hail showers, dying out during the morning rain Tuesday evening, clearing around midnight.  
Good becoming moderate, locally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
South to southwest 7 to severe gale 9, with gusts to 60kt, veering west to southwest by midday and decreasing 6 to gale 8 by evening.  
Very rough, locally high in the north.  
Scattered rain or hail showers.  
Moderate occasionally poor.

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
