Met Office Aberdeen Meteorologist's View

Feeling rather cold at height under cloud cover.

Forecast for Wednesday 04 Aug 2021

Weather: Dry in the morning with some sunshine. Cloudier in the afternoon and evening with some slow moving showers developing, these occasionally heavy with a risk of a thunderstorm.

Maximum wind: Southerly 20 mph

Chance of cloud free mountain/hill tops above 800m: 80%

Visibility: Cloud lowering to 850 metres in heavier showers later, otherwise very good with good air clarity.

Temperature: **Glens:** Plus 7 rising to 19 Celsius
At 800m: Plus 6 rising to 12 Celsius
Freezing level: Above summits
