General Situation

A cool and showery northwesterly airflow will affect all areas, before it backs westerly or southwesterly as rain moves east across much of the United Kingdom during the next couple of days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 3 or 4, backing southeast 4 to 6, veering west or southwest later, occasionally 7 near Rattray Head.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in northwest and smooth in inner Moray Firth.

Showers, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 to 6, veering northwest 3 to 5, becoming variable 4 or less, the south or southeast 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate, but smooth in Moray Firth.

Occasional rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 3 or 4, becoming variable 4 or less, then southwest 5 to 7.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north, becoming slight or moderate later.

Showers at first, perhaps thundery, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 5 to 7, perhaps gale 8, becoming variable 4 or less, then southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight, occasionally moderate later in north.

Occasional rain.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 4 to 6, backing southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 or 6 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later offshore.

Showers at first, perhaps thundery, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight, occasionally moderate offshore, becoming smooth or slight.

Occasional rain.

Mainly good.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or northwest 4 to 6, backing southwest later.

Slight, occasionally smooth near shore and moderate later offshore.

Showers at first, occasional rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight.

Occasional rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, backing southwesterly later.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northeast.

Showers at first.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in northeast.

Occasional rain at first.

Good, occasionally moderate at first.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or northwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, backing southwesterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later in dover strait.

Slight, occasionally smooth.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 at first in dover strait.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Mainly fair.

Good.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

Northwest, backing southwest, 4 or 5.

Slight or moderate becoming mainly moderate.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway - (SWW)

West 4 or 5, backing southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.
Slight becoming moderate.
Showers, occasional rain later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first.
Slight or moderate.
Occasional rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Isle of Man - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
West 4 or 5, backing southwest 5 or 6 later.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Westerly or southwesterly 3 to 5, increasing 6 later, occasionally 7 in far northwest.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north, becoming slight or moderate later, occasionally rough in far northwest.
Showers then occasional rain.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first in far northwest.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in far northwest.
Occasional rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Westerly or southwesterly 3 to 5, occasionally 6 later.

Smooth or slight becoming slight or moderate.

Showers then occasional rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 to 6.

Slight or moderate becoming mainly slight.

Occasional rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4, increasing 5 to 7.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate or rough.

Showers then occasional rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

West or southwest 4 to 6, occasionally 7 at first.

Moderate or rough, becoming moderate, occasionally slight near shore.

Occasional rain or showers.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 3 to 5, backing southwest 5 to 7, backing west or northwest 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough in north and later south.

Showers then rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

West or northwest 4 to 6, becoming variable 4 or less, then southwest 5 or 6 later.

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first in south and smooth north of skye.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

West 3 to 5, backing southwest 5 to 7, backing west or northwest 4 to 6 later.

Moderate or rough.

Showers then rain.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or northwest 4 to 6, becoming variable 4 or less, then southwest 5 or 6 later.

Moderate or rough becoming moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

A weak ridge of high pressure toppling east across Shetland waters on Sunday

with a shallow area of low pressure reaching northwest Scotland on Monday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil at time of issue.

Westerly or northwesterly backing southwesterly 4 or 5
Moderate or rough, but slight in sheltered waters east of Shetland
Showers
Mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Monday 02 Sep until 1800 UTC on Monday 02 Sep:
Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming cyclonic 3 or 4 in south
Moderate or rough, but slight in sheltered water east of Shetland.
Rain or showers
Moderate or good

Channel Islands
24 hour forecast:
Northwesterly 3 to 5, decreasing 2 to 4 overnight, backing northwest to west
Monday morning.
Slight.
Risk of showers.
Good, perhaps locally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Northwest to west 2 to 4, backing westerly late evening.
Mainly slight, with a low swell.
Isolated showers developing overnight.
Good, perhaps locally moderate.

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
